### **RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE**

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements
  of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not
  preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application
  process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 10. Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.
- 11. This rental does not authorize the construction of a well.





Re: Water Supply Bank Rental Application 1715

**Purpose/Narrative:** An application was received April 30, 2020 on behalf of Esther and Shane Machen requesting a rental of Eastern Snake River Plain Aquifer (ESPA) water for 2020. The Machens have submitted the rental to supplement their existing irrigation water rights (25-14420, 14421, 14422, 14423, 14429 and 14430) to cover the entirety of their parcel with water for irrigation, excluding the residence and hardscaped areas.

The intended place of use as noted on the application appears to be already covered by water rights held by the Machens along the back of their parcel while the front areas do not appear to have any water rights associated. Because it is permissible for a water user to reconfigure their place of use within a 40 acre quarter-quarter or government lot, it appears the Machens intend to use their water rights to irrigate the areas that do not feature a water right and use the rental to supplement the back section to avoid over-use or enlargement.

**Authority to File:** The application was signed by both Shane and Esther Machen and submitted by their representative at JCH Engineering. Review of IDWR data indicates they are the current water right holder for the water rights being supplemented and Bonneville County parcel data indicates they are also the current land owners. No concerns at about authority to file.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water rights being requested are leased to the Bank and there are no concerns about their validity.. The water rights being supplemented have been used in recent years for irrigation of up to 7.8 acres. No concerns about the validity of the water rights being supplemented.

**Injury Evaluation:** ESPA modeling has been provided and, based on the amounts being rented, no further mitigation is required. No injury concerns at this time.

**Enlargement of Use:** The applicants are renting water rights to supplement their existing irrigation water rights. Because all water will be diverted through the same point, the rate and volume per acre will be calibrated such that they can all be diverted without causing an overall enlargement. The applicant's water rights provide for irrigation of 7.8 acres with a per-acre diversion rate and volume of 0.14 cfs/ac and 3.5 afa/ac, respectively and conditions on the applicant's water rights limit them to no more than 0.02 cfs/ac 4.0 afa/ac, when used with other water rights.

The applicant stated that their desired irrigation diversion rate is 0.07 cfs for the irrigation of an additional 4.5 acres (equivalent to 0.16 cfs/ac). However, they also stated on four of their rental application that they were requesting a rental of 0.6 cfs from water rights 29-14106 and 14107. Water rights 29-14106 and 14107 authorize irrigation at a per-acre rate of 0.013 cfs/ac and a rental of 0.6 cfs from these water rights for the irrigation of 4.5 acres would equate to 0.013 cfs/ac. To address this discrepancy, between the diversion rate requested (on page two of the application) and the diversion rate rented from the requested water rights (on page four of the application), this rental will be for 0.07 cfs from water rights 29-14106 and 14107.

A rental authorizing an additional diversion of 0.07 cfs would allow for an overall diversion rate of 0.11 cfs for the irrigation of 12.3 cfs of the applicant's property (equivalent to 0.15 cfs/ac). As such, enlargement should be avoided as no more than 0.02 cfs/ac will be authorized for overall irrigation of the property through this rental.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the rental.

**Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources:** Irrigation is a beneficial use. The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

**Water Supply Bank Evaluation:** Bank staff recommend the approval of this application for Mr. and Ms. Machen for a single year, through the end of 2020.
