Term of Rental: This rental agreement shall take effect when all parties have signed it and shall continue in effect until December 31, 2024. Use of rental water shall be authorized as of either the date this rental agreement takes effect or the first day of the rental season of use, in 2020, whichever occurs last.

Annual Rental Fee:

2020 - 2022: \$913.60 annually
2023 - 2024: \$1,050.64 annually

The full fee for the rental of the above-described right(s) is \$913.60 per year for years 2020 - 2022 and \$1,050.64 per year for years 2023 - 2024. The rental fee includes an administrative fee of \$424.00 per year for years 2020 - 2022 and \$487.60 per year for years 2023 - 2024. Note that the renter is obligated to pay only the administrative fees associated with the water right(s): 36-2684.

An annual payment shall be received by the Department on or before December 31 each year preceding the use of the rented water rights. The agreement will be void if payment is not received by the due date in a given year. Rental fees are non-refundable. To voluntarily terminate the agreement early, notify the Department in writing prior to the rental fee due date.

RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
9. Use of rights 36-2130C, 36-7850C, and 36-8106C when combined in this rental agreement is limited to 0.13 cfs, 27.2 afa, and the irrigation of 6.8 acres.
10. This rental when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.

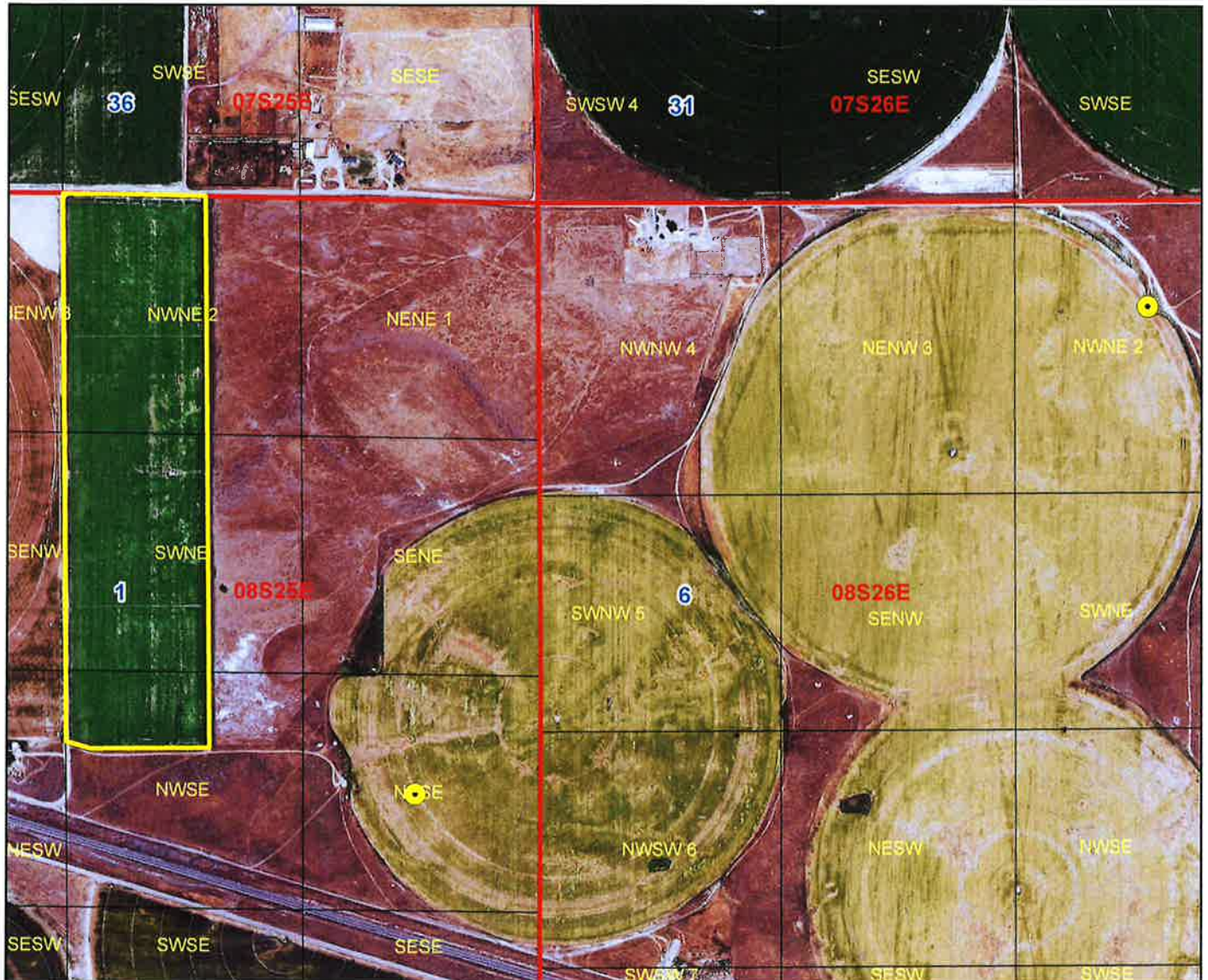

11. Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 130.
12. Upon specific notification of the Department, the renter shall install and maintain data loggers to record water usage information at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications.
13. Prior to the diversion and use of water under this rental agreement, the renter shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device(s) at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications, or shall obtain an approved variance from the Department to determine the amount of water diverted from power records or to maintain an existing measuring device.
14. Prior to December 31 of each year, the Board may review this rental agreement to determine whether it is consistent with the management plan that may be approved for the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer Ground Water Management Area ("ESPA GWMA Plan") pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-233b. The Board may cancel this rental agreement if the Board determines it is not consistent with the ESPA GWMA plan. If this rental agreement is canceled, the cancellation shall not take effect until December 31 of the year in which the rental agreement is canceled.
15. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.
16. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1412(6), this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.

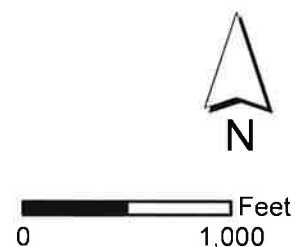

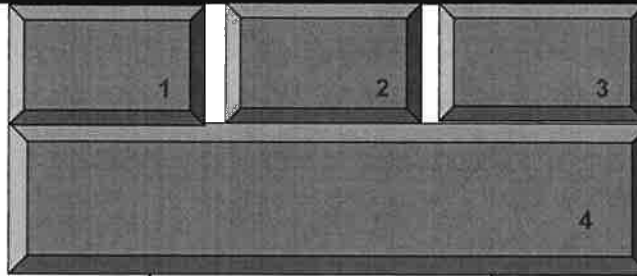

Purpose/Narrative: Application to rent water from the Water Supply Bank (Bank) was received from Greg Sullivan of Brockway Engineering on behalf of Grant 4D Farms on March 4, 2020. The application proposes to rent 212 acre feet at a rate of 0.90 cfs for the irrigation of 53 acres, for a duration of 5 years. This is essentially a renewal of a rental agreement 37, initiated in 2015 and expired December 31, 2019. The rental points of diversion (POD) are within the Eastern Snake Plane Aquifer Modeling (ESPAM) boundaries and therefore require ETRAM modeling, which was submitted with the application. The lease application for right 36-2684 included an agreement between Douglas and Laurel Grant and Grant 4D Farms stating they have a private agreement for the rental of WR 36-2684 and is signed by Douglas Grant and Duane R. Grant of Grant 4D Farms.

Authority to File: The application to rent water was submitted by Greg Sullivan of Brockway Engineering on behalf of Grant 4D Farms LLC, and was signed by Duane R. Grant, who is listed as an LLC member on the Secretary of State annual business report. According to taxlot data available to the Department, the land at the proposed POU and PODs is owned by RLDR Farm, LLC. The 2015 rental application included a signed agreement between Duane R. Grant of Grant 4D Farms and Bob Honsinger, registered agent for RLDR Farm, providing access to Grant 4D Farm to the PODs and allowing irrigation and farming of the land at the POU. This agreement was dated to last through the irrigation seasons of 2015 through 2020. The application proposes to rent water for 5 years, through 2024, and therefore a new agreement was requested from the applicant.

On April 21, 2020, an updated permission letter was received via email from Greg Sullivan, providing permission for Grant 4D Farms to operate on land owned by RLDR Farms through 2025. The letter was signed by the same parties as the earlier referenced permission letter.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: Water rights 36-2130C, 36-7850C and 36-8106C were all decreed in 1997. These rights share the same place of use (POU) and are stacked together through a combined rate, volume, and acre limit. Equal portions of each right, correlating to unirrigated field corners, have been leased to the bank since 2004. Examination of historical NDVI data show evidence of irrigation across the entire POU as late as 1999.

Right 36-2684 was decreed in 2001 and portions of the right, correlating to unirrigated field corners, have been leased to the Bank since 2004. Another unirrigated portion of the right POU located in the NE quarter of Sec. 28, T07S, R 25E is enrolled in the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP), and correspondence with the Idaho Soil and Water Conservation Commission confirmed the CREP contract is valid through 2021.

There are no concerns as to the validity of any of the requested rights.

Injury Evaluation/Rentability:

The rental and lease PODs are all located within the ESPAM modeling boundary and therefore required modeling to determine if there would be any adverse affects to other rights by the completion of this rental, and if mitigation would be required. Modeling was submitted with the application, and the results showed no adverse affects or mitigation required. I reviewed this data closely and re-ran the model using my own calculations, and came to the same results.

Additionally, this same rental took place from 2015 to 2019 with no known issues or complaints from other water right owners. There are no further concerns of injury to other rights.

Enlargement of Use/Rentability: Rights 36-2130C, 36-7850C, & 36-8106C contain a combined rate limit of 5.41 cfs, acre limit of 290 acres, and volume limit of 1160 af. The face of each right is also for 290 acres, so equal proportions of each right's acres were leased to the Bank. The combined rate limit is additive of the rates on the face of all three rights, so the associated rate/acre for each right was also leased to the bank. The rental application proposes to rent 6.8 acres of each right and a total of 6.8 acres for all three rights, as well as a total of 0.13 cfs from all three rights, which is the additive rate for 6.8 acres of each right. The combined volume limit is equal to the standard headgate volume of 4 af per acre for the location of the lease POD, and the standard headgate volume is the same at the rental POD. The application proposes to rent 4 af per acre for the 6.8 acres of these rights being rented, for a total volume of 27.2 af per year for all three rights.

Right 36-2684 has no combined limits. The application proposes to rent 46.2 acres of this right, along with the associated rate of 0.77 cfs and volume of 184.4 af.

Water rights 36-2261, 36-2130D, 36-7850D, 36-8106D and 36-2101 are also diverted through the PODs listed on the rental application, however the POU for the rental is not covered by the POU description of any of these rights, nor by any other rights.
