




SCREEN SIDE VIEW

FISH EQUALIZER DETAIL SCALE:1"=2"








SCREEN SIDE VIEW

This application proposes the diversion and use of water from a tributary of the Salmon Wild & Scenic River. The decreed minimum stream flow rights for the federal Wild & Scenic Rivers are subordinate to certain categories of water use and to specific amounts of water use established after the minimum stream flow.
