## **ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES**

TP-85-43

This is to certify that the department has examined this application for temporary approval to use water under the provisions of Section 42-202A, Idaho Code, and has determined that:

- A. The application for temporary approval should be denied.
- B. The application for temporary approval should be approved, since
  - 1. The temporary approval can be properly administered.
  - 2. Other water sources are not readily available.
  - 3. The approval is in the public interest.
  - 4. The approval will not injure known public values associated with the water source or any known water rights.

This application is therefore hereby:

A. DENIED

✓ B. APPROVED, subject to the following conditions:

1. Diversion and use of water under this approval is subject to all valid existing water rights.

- 2. The applicant assumes all risk the use of the water under this approval may injure other water rights.
- 3. This approval authorizes a maximum diversion of  $\frac{\partial_{r}\partial^{3}}{\partial r}$  AF and a maximum rate of diversion of  $\frac{\partial_{r}\partial 2}{\partial r}$  cfs.
- 4. This approval does not grant a right-of-way across the land of another, does not create a continuing right to use the water and may not be used in connection with a use which requires a continuing water supply.
- 5. The department may cancel this approval at any time if the department identifies injury to other water rights.
- 6. This approval does not create a continuing right to use water.
- 7. The holder of this temporary permit shall not divert at a rate or in a manner that will significantly reduce the flow in the water source or otherwise adversely affect fish, wildlife or other public values.
- 8. Water intakes should be screened to prevent entrainment or impingement of fish or other aquatic life. The maximum screen mesh size should be 0.25 inches; approach velocities should not exceed 0.5 ft/second.
- 9. The Idaho Department of Fish & Game (IDFG) now requires a Special Use Permit if their property is to be used for a point of diversion. IDFG contact in Coeur d'Alene ~ 208-769-1414, and in Lewiston ~ 208-799-5010.
- 10. All equipment involved with transporting water shall be treated/sterilized prior to use to avoid spread of invasive aquatic species and may require inspection. 11. This approval expires on  $D_{ec}$  31 , 2015.

Dear Mr. Frederick:

We received your letter requesting our comments on the approval of the 2015 temporary water appropriation applications from the Nez Perce County Road and Bridge Department to draw a total of 5.03 acre-feet of water from the Clearwater River at both the Spalding and Lenore boat ramps for road construction purposes. The two applications are renewals that have been issued in past years. Assuming all federal, state and local permits have been obtained, regulations met, and reviews completed, we offer the following comments.

The two sections of the Clearwater River at Lenore and at Spaulding are protected for cold water and salmonid spawning aquatic life, primary contact recreation and domestic water supply designated beneficial uses. In the Idaho Water Quality Standards, the section of the Clearwater River at Lenore is included in water body ID 17060306CL013\_07 and is currently listed in Category 5 of the Idaho 2012 Integrated Report as not supporting the cold water aquatic life beneficial use due to dissolved gas supersaturation. The section of the Clearwater River at Spalding is included in water body ID 17060306CL002\_07 and is currently listed in Category 2 of the Idaho 2012 Integrated Report as supporting designated beneficial uses. DEQ believes the Clearwater River flow at both points of diversion is significant enough that the beneficial uses should not be impacted by these temporary water appropriations.
