





EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:

<u>PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION</u>

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. Note: the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

- (a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or
- (b) The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.

APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, if this preliminary order becomes final, any party aggrieved by the final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal the final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

Evaluation of Sufficiency of Information Submitted

The transfer proposes to move the point of diversion for water rights 3-10233 and 3-10234 just downstream to an improved diversion structure.

The site is on the Snake River approximately 1/8 miles South of the intersection of Airport Rd and Hansen Rd in Weiser, ID.

Summary of Information Submitted

Authority to File: Reed and Melinda Mulkey filed and signed the transfer application. Applicants own land between old POD and proposed POD. IDWR records show them as the active water right holders and they should be considered to have authority to file.

Water Right Validity:

The decrees for water right no.'s 3-10233 and 3-10234 were issued July 9, 2007. These rights should be presumed to be valid since beneficial use has occurred within the last five years. Beneficial use confirmed by department staff using aerial imagery, and landsat data that show evidence of irrigation taking place. Evidence of beneficial use does not need to be added to the file as it is an IDWR product available to other staff.

Overlap Analysis:

No POU overlap is found. There are other rights nearby, however because the existing POU will not be changing there is no concern for POU overlap being created through this transfer. POD overlap analysis found seven other existing rights at existing POD. The proposed POD will have no other rights besides the two rights included in this transfer. POD overlap should not be a concern as a result of this transfer.

Injury to Other Water Rights:

None anticipated. The new point of diversion proposal is from the same source. Applicant owns the land between current POD and proposed POD. There are no existing water right POD's between the existing POD and proposed POD. Because the change in point of diversion will not be changing the amount of water sought by this right, there is no evidence to suggest that any injury to other rights will occur as a result of this transfer. The water right changes proposed through this transfer application do not appear to change the effect on the original or hydraulically connected water source or affect other water rights. Therefore, staff review of the transfer application found no cause to require public notice.

Enlargement of Use:

Water right 3-10233 authorizes 0.1 cfs for the irrigation of 5 acres and water right 3-10234 authorizes 0.05 cfs for the irrigation of 2.5 acres. None of these authorized parameters are anticipated to be increased as a result of this transfer. There are no proposed changes to the existing place of use, season

of use, or nature of use in this transfer proposal. As a result, the historic extent of beneficial use is not likely to be enlarged as a result of this transfer.

Local Public Interest: The transfer application proposes beneficial use consistent with local public interest.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The application proposes beneficial use consistent with conservation of water resources in Idaho.

The application is consistent with criteria of I. C. § 42-222 and should be processed.
