

EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. Note: the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

- (a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or
- (b) The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.

APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, if this preliminary order becomes final, any party aggrieved by the final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal the final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

The appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of this preliminary order becoming final. See section 67-5273, Idaho Code. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.

Summary of Application Proposal

Narrative: Transfer 84026 proposes to move the point of diversion for water rights 65-23807 approximately 0.5 miles upstream on the Middle Fork Payette River. The new point of diversion will continue to pump directly from the river irrigating 1.4 acres. Water will be used at the current place of use approximately 3.5 miles north of Crouch, Idaho in Boise County near the end of Pyle Creek Road.

Location of Application Proposal: The proposed change is located approximately .5 miles north of Crouch, Idaho in Boise County near the end of Pyle Creek Road.

Summary of Information Submitted

Authority to File: The application was filed in the name of Mike Ruffner residing at 30 Pyle Creek Road, Garden Valley, ID 83622. Water right 65-23807 was found to be in the name of Michel J. Ruffner and Amanda G. Ruffner with an address list as 1326 E Prairie View Dr, Eagle, ID. Initially, the application was signed only by Mike Ruffner. On May 10, 2020, a signature page was received with both signatures. Tax parcel information obtained by the Department and dated 10/17/2019 show the property, Block 2, Lot 13 of Middlefork Meadows Subdivision, jointly owned by the applicants. Both the proposed POD and the current POU are located on this property.

Water Right Validity/Historical Beneficial Use: Water right 65-23807 is an irrigation right from the Middle Fork Payette River decreed on 11/3/2000. Aerial imagery does not indicate evidence of irrigation at the place of use. Landsat, and Sentinel data are inconclusive due to the size of the parcel. Early Landsat images from 2000 seem to clearly indicate a lack of irrigation. However, Sentinel data retrieved for 2019 seems to indicate changes. Google Earth imagery for 2018 clearly shows the new construction within the parcel. A letter was sent to the applicants on June 3, 2020 requesting information regarding the potential forfeiture of the water right. An email with an attached map received on July 10, 2020, depicts sprinkler lines and rotary sprinkler locations on the property overlaid on the 2018 Google Earth imagery.

Overlap Analysis: Overlap analysis in GIS show water rights 6513002 and 13335 as overlapping, however on closer scrutiny of the backfile these are clearly separate parcels sharing the same quarter-quarter.

Injury to Other Water Rights: None anticipated, though there are other surface water diversions between the current POD and the new POD location. There is no information to suggest this is a gaining or losing reach of the river.

Enlargement of Use: IDWR's Administrator's Memorandum 24 Transfer Processing Policies & Procedures section 5d, enlargement of use, elicits a concern with multiple points of diversion in item 10, enhancing water supply. Item 10 states, "an application for transfer, which proposes to change a point of diversion from a surface water source to a new location where the water available is greater or more reliable, such as moving from the tributary of a stream downstream to the mainstem of the stream, is presumed to enlarge the water right, unless the proposed change is subject to conditions limiting diversion of water at the proposed new point of diversion to times when water is available and in priority at the original point of diversion."


There is no evidence that the new point of diversion will cause enlargement by enhancing supply, since there is no evidence of limited flow in this section of river.

Local Public Interest: No issues were identified. It is within the local public interest to allow private properties to develop their property and use their water rights to the fullest extent which in turn benefits the public at large. It is within the local public interest to allow the change in POD.


Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The application proposes beneficial use consistent with conservation of water resources in Idaho by continuing to irrigate agricultural lands.



• Water right 65-23807 authorizes 0.01 cfs, for the irrigation of 1.3 acres. Review of historical imagery does not indicate any evidence of irrigation.

Idaho Code §42-222(2) states in part: All rights to the use of water acquired under this chapter or otherwise shall be lost and forfeited by a failure for the term of five (5) years to apply it to the beneficial use for which it was appropriated and when any right to the use of water shall be lost through nonuse or forfeiture such rights to such water shall revert to the state and be again subject to appropriation under this chapter; except that any right to the use of water shall not be lost through forfeiture by the failure to apply the water to beneficial use under certain circumstances as specified in section 42-223.
