This is to certify that the department has examined this application for temporary approval to use water under the provisions of Section 42-202a, Idaho Code, and has determined that:

- 9. Direct discharge of waste water/slurry into rivers, creeks, or streams is not authorized.
- 10. All equipment involved with transporting water shall be treated/sterilized prior to use to avoid spread of invasive aquatic species and may require inspection. - 11. This temporary use of water remains subject to control of the Boise River Watermaster.

Please be advised, this permit is subject to the effective dates and conditions stated on page 2 of the application. Water sufficiency for senior water rights along with associated public values must be protected during summer-fall low flows. Elk Creek is the primary water source for Idaho City. Therefore the approval expires on <u>August 1, 2016</u>.

Also, note the condition requiring the **purchase of storage water from the Boise River Rental pool** to mitigate injury to downstream water right holders below Lucky Peak.
