

#### **Re:** Temporary Water Appropriation Applications

To Whom it May Concern:

This letter is written on behalf of Otis Gold Corporation (Otis) concerning three temporary water withdrawal requests, (TP-31-34, TP-31-35, and TP-31-36) that were previously approved on August 18, 2015. Klepfer Mining Services (KMS) is providing services to Otis Gold on their Kilgore Exploration Project.

The primary water source will be an exploration drill hole that was previously approved for temporary appropriations. Due to the seasonal aspect of flows in the area, two additional points of diversions are required as backup water sources. The application form did not allow space for three points of diversions, so we completed an application for each of the three locations.

It is our intent to be allowed three points of diversion (same as previously approved), as outlined in each application, which will operate under the combined volume of 5 acre-feet limitation. Included are the following:

- Mineral Exploration Drill Hole Application, Map and Fee;
- West Camas Creek Application, Map, and Fee; and
- Unnamed Stream Application, Map and Fee.
