This Department has recently completed the preliminary processing of the above-referenced Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the state of Idaho.

Although there were no protests received by the Department against the approval of said application, the Department is presently delaying further action (approval of the application) because the groundwater source identified on the application is located in the Twin Falls Groundwater Management Area.

The Department will hold your application without approval pending evidence that there is water available for your use.

It is possible for you to drill a well and to use the water for single family domestic purposes without a water right permit, although you would have to obtain a separate "drilling permit". If water is used from a well in compliance with the definition of domestic use, a water right permit is not required. Water used for heating on one home is included in the definition of domestic use.
