1. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before **March 1, 1991**.
2. Subject to all prior water rights.
3. Any license issued by IDWR pursuant to the permit or portion thereof for the use of trust water is subject to a term review of 20 years after the date of this approval to determine availability of water for the use and to re-evaluate the public interest at the end of the term.
4. Diversion and use of water under this permit is subject to an annual use fee if rules are subsequently promulgated which provide for the submittal of the fee.
5. The Director retains jurisdiction of the permit and/or subsequent license issued to change, add or remove any requirement as determined to be appropriate.
6. The rate of diversion of water for irrigation under this permit and all other water rights on the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.

NOTICE OF PENDING ORDER VOIDING APPLICATION

On March 30, 1983, you filed with the Department of Water Resources (Department) Application for Permit No. 47-7869 which proposed the diversion of 0.40 cubic feet per second from wastewater tributary to Salmon Falls Creek for the irrigation of 20 acres.

The Department mailed a letter and questionnaire to you on October 23, 1989 in connection with the application. The letter provided notice that the Department was reviewing the application in connection with development which was not complete prior to October 1, 1984.

This letter also requested that you return the Department's questionnaire concerning your present possessory interest in the place of use, any prior development under the application and/or your plans for pursuing completion of the proposed project. The letter notified you that failure to complete and return the questionnaire within thirty (30) days of the date of the letter was cause for the Department to void the application.

The purpose of this letter is to provide a second and final opportunity for you to submit the requested information. If you fail to respond to this inquiry within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter, the Department will issue an order voiding the application pursuant to Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,1.

If no development has been completed as proposed by the application, and you are no longer interested in pursuing the development, please complete and return the enclosed withdrawal form. Please note, if you are using water under this right, 47-7869, the Department may issue an order requiring you to cease diverting the water.

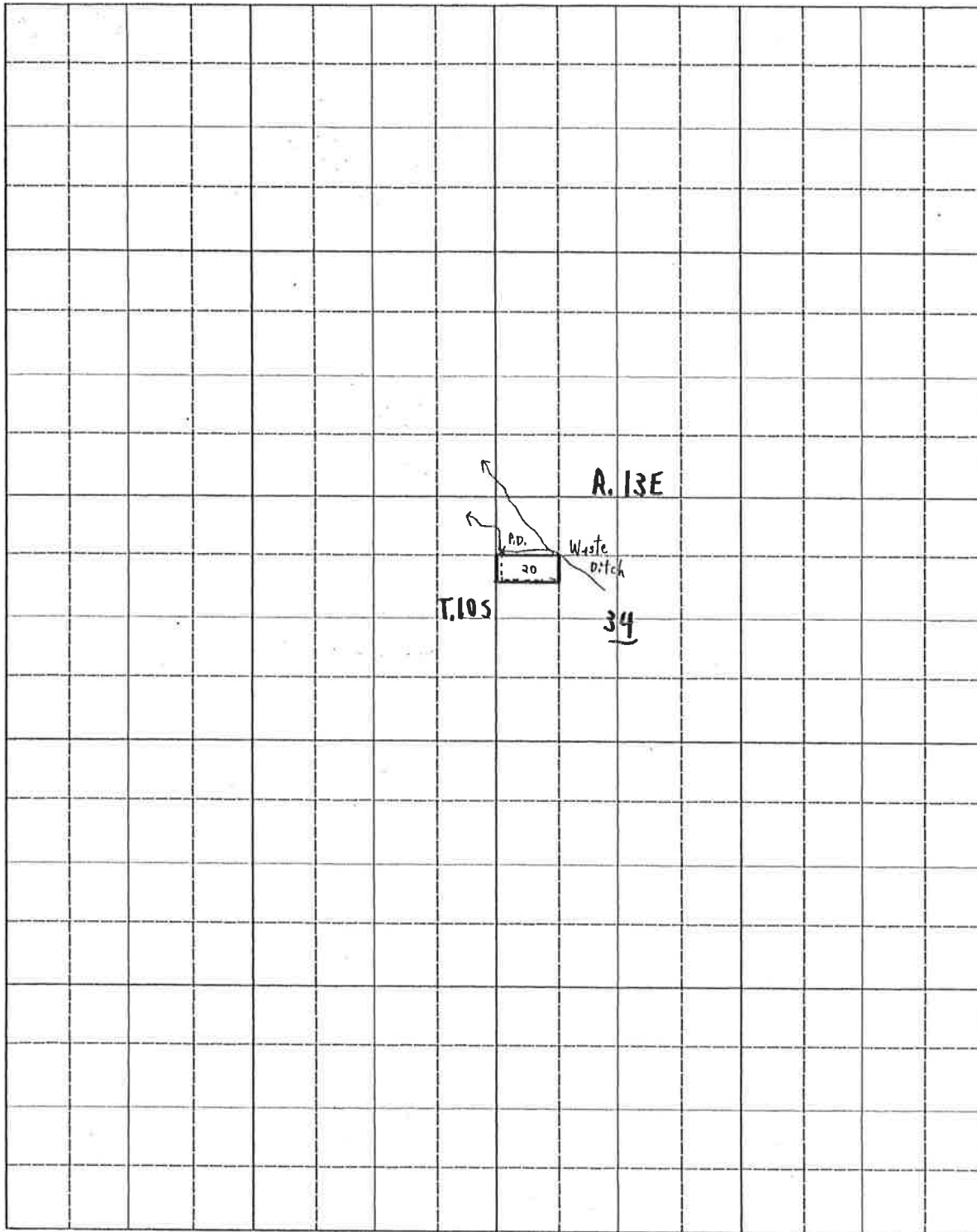

Ownership changes were never done and an application for permit (47-07870) and a permit (47-07869) both lapsed shortly after he purchased the property. He claims he never knew anything about them and the former owner (Haley) threw away any letters we sent him. Told him he may be able to resurrect the permits if he can prove that the systems were in use prior to the proof due date in 1991. If not, any new commercial use would not be permitted at this time because of the moratorium. Gave him some information on how to prove usage and a couple of ownership change forms.
