Temp. App. – TP-77-51 Midas Gold Inc..

Action of the Director of the Department of Water Resources

This is to certify that the Department has examined this application for temporary approval to use water under the provision of Section 42-202a Idaho Code, and has determined that:

The application for temporary approval should be **Approved** since

- 1. The temporary approval can be properly administered
- 2. Other water sources are not readily available
- 3. The approval is in the public interest
- 4. The approval will not injure know public values associated with the water source or any known water rights.
- 5. Comments have been sought from the US Forest Service, Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game, and Idaho Department of Environmental Quality under previous authorization TP-77-34.

Approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Diversion and use of water under this approval is subject to all valid existing water rights.
- 2. The applicant assumes all risk for the use of water under this approval and injury to other water rights.
- 3. This approval authorizes a maximum diversion volume of **5.0 acre-feet** and a maximum diversion rate of **350 gallons per minute.** Record for the water diversion volume (number of truck loads) will be kept by the holder. The records shall be provided to the Department upon request.
- 3. This approval does not grant a right-of-way across the land of another, does not create a continuing right to use the water, and may not be used in connection with a use which requires a continuing water supply.
- 4. The Department may cancel this approval at any time if the Department identifies injury to other water rights.
- 5. This approval commences on March 1, 2014 and expires on March 1, 2015.



- 6. The holder of this temporary permit shall not divert at a rate or in a manner that will significantly reduce the flow in the water source or otherwise adversely affect fish, wildlife or other public values. At no time shall the diversion rate exceed 25% of the total creek flow.
- 7. A ¼ inch mesh screen shall cover the pump intake.
- 9. Direct discharge of waste flow/material into any stream or draw is not authorized. Discharge and processing of slurry/waste materials will comply with Forest Service and related regulatory agency permits and regulations.
- 10. The water use approved herein is subject to and shall conform to the terms of the approved Forest Service Plan of Operations for this location.
- 11. Site activities must comply with Idaho Water Quality Standards
- 12. This temporary permit is mitigated by water right no. 77-7293

Application for Temporary Water Appropriation No. TP-77-51 in the name of Midas Gold Inc. is hereby approved.


