The Department of Water Resources ("department") has completed its review of the Applications to Sell or Lease Water Right(s) to the Water Supply Bank ("bank"). Please consider that the offered water right(s) are accepted into the bank.

WATER SUPPLY BANK LEASE CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

1. Portions of the above referenced water rights are leased to the bank as follows:

Acres Diversion Rate Diversion Volume Right No. (ac) (cubic ft per sec., cfs) (acre-feet, af) See above 111ac 1.65cfs 333 ac

- 2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.
- 3. While a right is in the bank, the owner of the right may not use the right without approval of the department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Section 42-351, Idaho Code, for illegal diversion and use of water, and may include civil penalties pursuant to Section 42-1701B, Idaho Code.
- 4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, the lease term expires, or upon request from the lessor to change the term of the lease.

- 5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed.
- 6. Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 7. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate as specified by the lessor.
- 8. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.
- 9. Upon acceptance of a water right into the Board's water supply bank, the owner of the right may withdraw the right within thirty (30) days of acceptance into the bank if the owner does not agree with the conditions of acceptance.

The right(s) will automatically be released from the bank on **December 31, 2005**, unless the right(s) are released earlier by the Board, or upon request by the lessor. To change the term of the lease or to release the right(s) from the bank, the lessor must submit a request in writing to the department prior to the release date.

RE: WARNING OF EXCESS DIVERSION, Stoker Dairy, Burley

Dear Water Users:

It has come to my attention that total diversions at your dairy appear to be in excess of your authorizing water rights. I can find no other water rights for commercial use at this location.

The Stoker dairy is operating under water rights which were changed by the approval of Transfer No. 68509 to authorize a combined instantaneous rate of diversion of 0.55 cfs and a total annual diverted volume of 132.8 acre-feet for a commercial dairy. The annual measurement report submitted to the West Water Measurement District (WMD) for 2001 indicates that withdrawals from the dairy well were 418 acre-feet, which is more than three times the authorized water right volume.

A certification test of your McCrometer flow meter, conducted by Corbin Knowles in November 2000, indicated that the meter was operating properly. However, when Mr. Knowles visited your facility in spring 2001, he learned that the meter had been damaged during the installation of an ozone purification unit, and a new meter was to be installed. Butte Irrigation confirmed that you purchased a used McCrometer flow meter from them on 6-9-01. The new meter has not been certified by the WMD. Mr. Knowles visited your facility at the end of 2001 and took an audit reading from the new flow meter.

Your 2001 report does not reflect the installation of a new meter. In fact, the new meter has totalizing units of gallons X 1000, and the old meter used totalizing units of acre-feet X .0001, yet your annual report shows odometer readings in thousands of gallons for the entire year, even though the new meter was not in place the entire year. Because of the discrepancy in information and concern about recorded data for those months when the meter was either not installed or not operable, your 2001 report as filed is not acceptable.

You must take immediate steps to correct any over-appropriation by taking the following actions:

- Identify what additional water right covers your withdrawals if our records are not correct;
- Immediately cease diversion of ground water from the well for commercial uses in excess of 132.8 acre-feet annually; and

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Immediately contact the ESPA West Water Measurement District Hydrographer
to schedule a flow meter examination and calibration test. Your presence is
required at this exam to assure that meter information is recorded properly and
annual reports are submitted correctly.

If you are in the process of obtaining another water right or a water right transfer to cover this use or any expanded uses, please be advised that you are not authorized to divert in excess of the above right until the new water right or transfer is approved. To divert water in Idaho not in conformance with a valid water right is illegal. If you do not take immediate steps to correct over-appropriations and reporting deficiencies, the Department of Water Resources will proceed in action against you under the provisions of Idaho Code §42-1701B(5), and §42-351, resulting in the Issuance of a Notice of Violation and Cease and Desist Order. Civil penalties for continuing illegal water uses may be up to \$10,000 annually for each violation.

The 2002 report filed with the West WMD must contain actual monthly odometer readings from your flow meter. All readings should be taken on or about the first of each month. If you are not taking monthly readings, please begin to do so.
