

ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that the department has examined this application for temporary approval to use water under the provisions of Section 42-202a, Idaho Code, and has determined that: A) The application for temporary approval should be denied. B) The application for temporary approval should be approved, since: The temporary approval can be properly administered. Other water sources are not readily available. The approval is in the public interest. The approval will not injure known public values associated with the water source or any known water rights. This application is therefore hereby: A) DENIED B) APPROVED, subject to the following conditions: Diversion and use of water under this approval is subject to all valid existing water rights. The applicant assumes all risk the use of the water under this approval may injure other water rights. This authorizes a maximum diversion of 100 AF and a maximum rate of diversion of 1003. This approval does not grant a right-of-way across the land of another, does not create a continuing right to use the water 4. and may not be used in connection with a use which requires a continuing water supply. The department may cancel this approval at any time if the department identifies injury to other water rights. 5. This approval does not create a continuing right to use water. The holder of this temporary permit shall not divert at a rate or in a manner that will significantly reduce the flow in the 7. water source or otherwise adversely affect fish, wildlife or other public vaules. A ¼ inch mesh screen shall be installed on the pump intake. Direct discharge of waste water/slurry into rivers, creeks, or streams is <u>not</u> authorized. 10. All equipment involved with transporting water shall be treated/sterilized prior to use to avoid spread of invasive aquatic species and may require inspection.
