The Lower Coeur d'Alene Streambank Stabilization Pilot Project is funded by USEPA through the Clean Water Act program. The purpose of the project is to investigate several different methodologies for stabilizing eroding streambanks in the region between Harrison and Rose Lake. Construction on about 1700 feet of bank on both sides of the river was completed in January, 2005. Approximately 1100 feet of bank was revegetated with about 3000 upland, bank, and wetland woody and herbaceous plants in the spring of 2005. Watering is desired during the summer of 2005 to help establish these plants.
