Enclosed are copies of your approved Applications for Permit. We direct your attention to the conditions of approval on the fourth pages.

Please be advised that your applications for permit have been approved because we no longer wait for approval from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) or the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (PUC) when the flow is less than 25 cfs and the power to be generated is less than 500 HP. However, you may still need to obtain approval from FERC and/or PUC.

Be sure to note the special condition requiring you to install a measuring device, or an access port to provide for the installation of measuring equipment by the Department. Enclosed please find a list of measuring device options, and specifications for the installation of the access port.

The 1982 Idaho Legislature added a requirement that as a permit holder you must commence the excavation or construction of diverting works within one year of the date the permit was issued, and you must proceed diligently until the project is completed. The enclosed blue cards must be completed and returned to this office as soon as you commence construction, no later than one year from the date the permit was approved.

We have enclosed instructions entitled "Making Proof of Beneficial Use". Please read the instructions carefully since you must take further action to develop these permits into a licenses.

#### ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-7800, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.
- b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before October 1, 19 87.
- c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
- d. Other: Permit holder shall commence the excavation or construction of diverting works within one year of the date this permit is issued and shall proceed diligently until the project is complete.

An access port or other device as specified by the Department shall be installed by the permit holder to provide for the installation of measuring equipment and the determination of the rate of diversion by the Department.

This permit is subject to the provisions of Sections 42-205 through 42-210, Idaho Code, restricting the sale, transfer, assignment, or mortgage of this permit. Failure to comply with these provisions is cause for immediate cancellation of this permit.

This project shall be operated in a manner that will not conflict or interfere with the future diversion of water for irrigation or other beneficial consumption.

This permit does not constitute Idaho Public Utilities Commission or Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approval that may be required.
