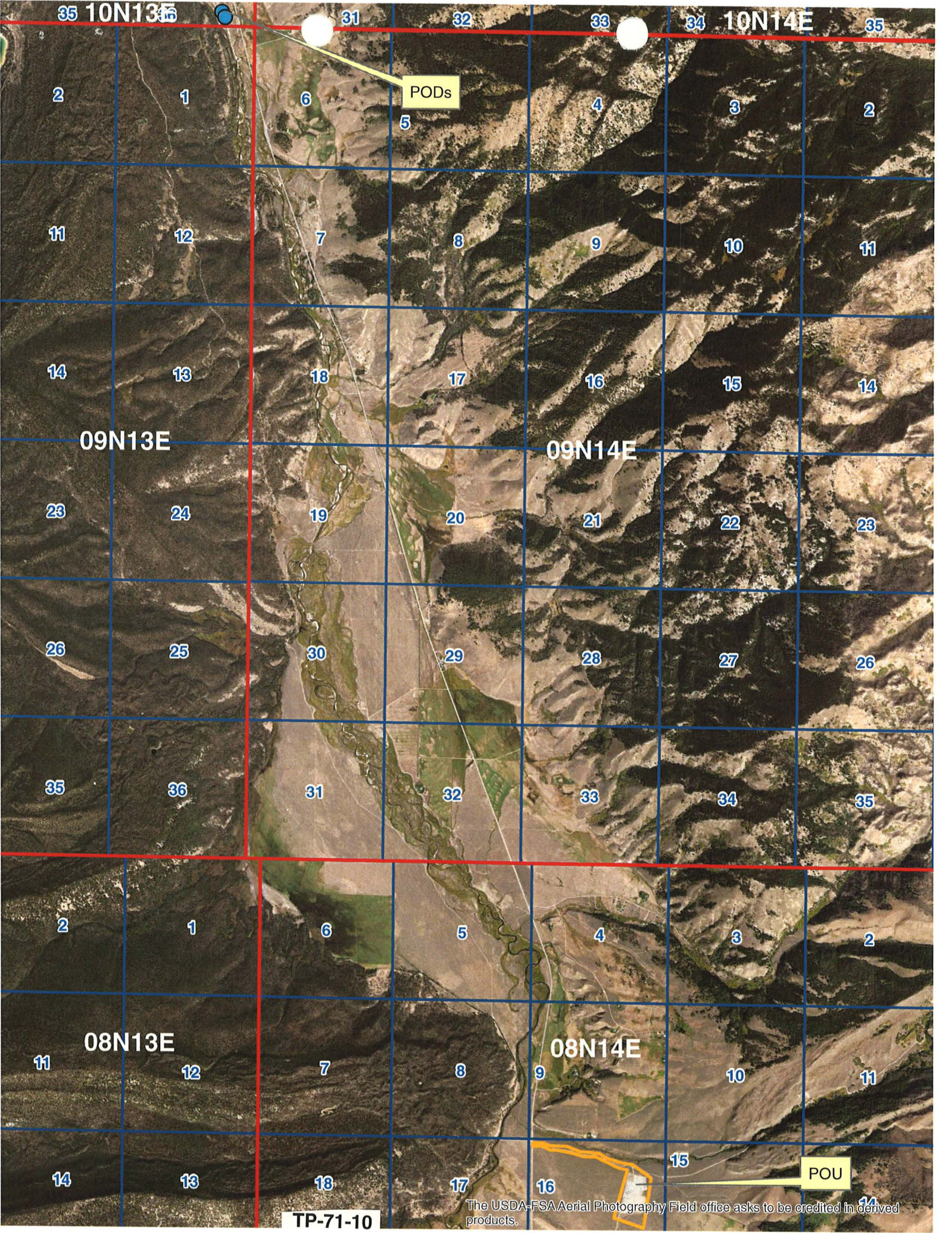

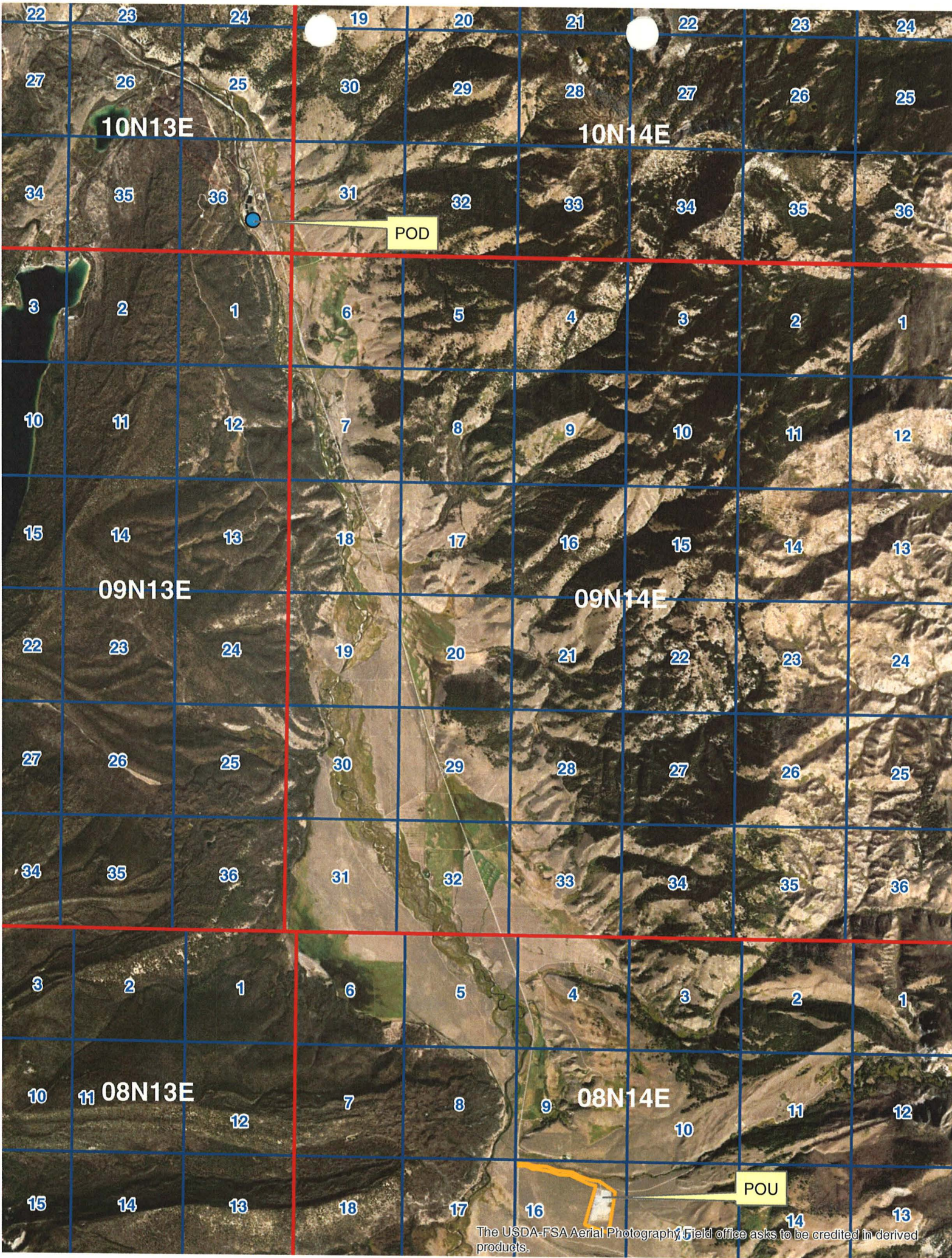

It is owned by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service.
