This office has reviewed the request for extension of time you submitted in connection with the above referenced permit.

The permit was issued for 9.0 cfs for diversion and use of water from a surface water source for power generation purposes. Based on the information provided on the request for extension of time, it does not appear that work has been accomplished in connection with diversion and use of water for power generation purposes as authorized by the permit. For this reason, the request cannot be approved as submitted.

If you have evidence to show that you have pursued the power development, please provide it to the Department within thirty (30) days. If suitable information is not received within this time period, the request for extension of time will be denied. The Idaho Code does not allow the Department to consider lack of financial resources to be an acceptable reason for lack of project development and completion.



ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-7677, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.
- b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before February 1, 19 88.
- c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
- d. Other:

An access port or other device as specified by the Department shall be installed by the permit holder to provide for the installation of measuring equipment and the determination of the rate of diversion by the Department.

The issuance of this permit in no way grants any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.

This permit is subject to the provisions of Sections 42-205 through 42-210, Idaho Code, restricting the sale, transfer, assignment, or mortgage of this permit. Failure to comply with these provisions is cause for immediate cancellation of this permit.

Permit holder shall commence the excavation or construction of diverting works within one year of the date this permit is issued and shall proceed diligently until the project is complete.

This permit does not constitute Idaho Public Utilities Commission or Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approval that may be required.

Use of water under this permit is subordinated to future diversion of water either upstream or downstream for irrigation or other consumptive beneficial uses.
