#### RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements
  of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not
  preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application
  process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. This rental agreement right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre and 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.

- 10. The period of use for the irrigation described in this approval may be extended to a beginning date of 4/1 and an ending date of 10/31 provided that beneficial use of the water can be shown and other elements of the right are not exceeded. The use of water before 5/1 and after 10/15 is subordinate to all water rights having no subordinated early or late irrigation use and a priority date earlier than 3/22/2004.
- 11. Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 120.
- 12. Upon specific notification of the Department, the renter shall install and maintain data loggers to record water usage information at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications.
- 13. Prior to the diversion and use of water under this rental agreement, the renter shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device(s) at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications, or shall obtain an approved variance from the Department to determine the amount of water diverted from power records or to maintain an existing measuring device.
- 14. Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014
- 15. This rental agreement does not grant any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
- 16. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.




### Attachment to Water Supply Bank Rental Agreement No. 441



Please find enclosed a receipt in the amount of \$2,270.00 and a copy of a fully executed Water Supply Bank Rental Agreement of 94.6 acre-feet of water for irrigation of 13 acres. Upon receipt of this fully executed agreement, you are authorized to divert water in compliance with the conditions of water use described in the agreement.

Pursuant to the Water Supply Bank Rules, 90% or \$1,702.80 of the rental fee will be paid to the lessor(s) and 10% or \$189.20 will be retained by the Department to offset administrative costs.

**Purpose/Narrative:** An application was received by the Department April 30, 2020 from Mr. Randy Turpin requesting a rental of Eastern Snake River Plane Aquifer (ESPA) water for 2022. Prior to receiving the application, Mr. Turpin had worked with Bank staff to identify water rights available within his basin as well as an estimated amounts that could be used for preliminary modeling. While Mr. Turpin has requested a rental through 2022 it appears, based on the water rights available, that the rental will be limited to a single year.

This application was a continuation of a prior rental from 2019 through 2020, it appears Mr. Turpin wishes to irrigate acreage that is not otherwise covered by water rights and cannot receive canal shares.

**Authority to File:** The application was signed and submitted by Mr. Turpin along with a land use agreement from Murdock Family Farms signed by Zoanne McGary. No concerns at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water rights being used to facilitate this rental are valid and leased to the Bank. No concerns at this time

**Injury Evaluation:** No injury is apparent through this rental, preliminary modeling was prepared and reviewed prior to receiving the application. The information submitted was run on the latest version of the ETRAN program and, using the data provided, no further mitigation is required.

**Enlargement of Use:** No enlargement is evident as there are not water rights appurtenant to the property. Further, the area is also unable to receive irrigation from the People's Canal as such, this rental will be the only source of water for that acreage.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the rental.

**Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources:** The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.
