RECITALS

- 1. The Board is authorized under chapter 17, title 42, Idaho Code to operate a water supply bank and to contract with lessors to act as an intermediary in facilitating the rental of water.
- The Lessor has filed a completed application to lease water rights described below into the Water Supply Bank on forms supplied by the Idaho Department of Water Resources and received by the Department on October 17, 2019.
- 3. The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources has reviewed the application for compliance with the Water Supply Bank rules and has approved the Lease subject to conditions listed below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and contracts herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **WATER RIGHTS**: The Lessor shall lease and the Board shall accept into the Bank the Applicant's water rights described as follows:

- 3. **TERM OF LEASE**: The term of this lease shall be January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2024. This Lease shall bind the parties and take effect when both parties have signed it.
- 4. WATER SUPPLY BANK CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE: The Lessor shall abide by all terms and conditions contained in the Water Supply Bank Conditions of Acceptance, attached hereto as "Attachment A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

- 5. CHANGE OF WATER RIGHT: This lease specifies water right elements including but not limited to: diversion rates; diversion volumes; number of acres authorized to be irrigated; places of use; points of diversion; beneficial uses; and seasons of use. During the term of this lease, if a water right is administratively changed due to a water right split and renumbering, this lease may be reduced by an equal amount to reflect the water right elements as legally defined under the water right. If a lease contract cannot be reduced sufficient to reflect the legal definition of a water right as amended through a water right split and/or water right transfer, the Board may release the water right from the Water Supply Bank.
- 6. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT: This lease is between the Board and the Lessor, who is the recognized owner or designated representative of the recognized owners of water rights described herein. Should ownership of any part of a water right herein described change during the term of this lease, either through a water right split, a water right transfer, sale of property to which the water right is appurtenant, or through any other recognized water right reassignment, the lease benefits and obligations to the conditions of acceptance for any such water rights will be assigned to the new owners.
- 7. **DUPLICATE ORIGINAL**: This Lease is executed in duplicate. Each of the documents with an original signature of each party shall be an original.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate.
- 2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.
- 3. While a right is in the bank, the lessor may <u>not</u> use the right without approval of the Department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-351 for illegal diversion and use of water and may include civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701B.
- 4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, or the lease term expires. A right may be released from the bank upon request, provided the Board approves the release. Unless approved by the Department, leased rights may not be immediately available for release.
- 5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-223(5).
- 6. Rental of water under this right is subject to the limitations and conditions of approval of the water right.
- 7. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.
- Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other Department application process.



- 9. In accordance with Idaho Code § 42-248 and § 42-1409(6), all owners of water rights are required to notify the Department of any changes in mailing address or change in ownership of all or part of a water right. Notice must be provided within 120 days of the change.
- 10. If a water right leased into the Water Supply Bank is sold or conveyed during the lease term, and if the leased right was rented, the rental proceeds will be disbursed in the following manner regardless of any arrangements between the buyer(s) and seller(s) to the contrary:
 - a. Rental payments will go to the lessor(s) of record at the beginning of the rental season, even if the Department processes a Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership during the rental season.
 - b. New lessor(s) of record will receive payment for any subsequent rental seasons.
- 11. The water right(s) is leased to the bank subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
- 12. Place of use is located within Lots 1 Blk. 1; Buckhorn Subdivision No. 3.
- 13. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1412(6), this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.
- 14. The unleased portion of these rights are limited to the irrigation of 2.2 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
- 15. Use of water under this right will be regulated by a watermaster with the responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 37.



Except for the arena, most of the area indicated in hardscape is no longer being irrigated. The arena uses water for dust control.

Purpose/Narrative: An application to lease portions of water rights 37-20354 and 37-20355 was received by the Department October 17, 2019. From the information provided by the applicant, the area being offered for lease to the bank is hardscaped and irrigation is no longer necessary. The applicant wishes to place the acreage into the bank so that it is not lost to forfeiture should they decide at a later date to use the full extent of the right.

Based on the information provided, a review of the actual historic consumptive use may be warranted before the rights are rented, since the area has been previously hardscaped. It may be possible that injury or enlargement to the overall use of the surface water could occur if this right has not been used to its full extent or that, through a rental of this historically hardscaped acreage, injury could occur to other water rights within the area.

Authority to File: The application was signed by John Welsh and submitted by his representative, Fritz Haemmerle. Review of IDWR records show that the right is owned by both Mr. and Mrs. Welsh's Revocable Trust. Consent from the canal company has also been received as the water is delivered through the Hiawatha Canal company infrastructure. No concerns of the applicant's authority to propose this lease application at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: These water rights were decreed in 2009 with an 1886 priority date. The specific portions of these rights offered to the Bank for lease have been placed in the Water Supply Bank since 2015. As the rights were decreed in 2009, placed into the Bank in 2015 and are proposed again for lease, there has not been a 5 year period of non-use and forfeiture is not an issue.

The consumptive use and amount rentable of these rights remains questionable. The rights were decreed in 2009 and, per an ownership change document in the water right file, the current owners acquired the rights in 2013 and irrigated throughout that season, excluding the area covered by the residence and driveway. Per the affidavit provided, the area has since become hardscaped and irrigation is no longer necessary.

This leaves the question of what consumptive use can be measured from the acreage covered by the residence and driveway. Because the current owners are not aware of when the residence and driveway were constructed we can infer that it was during the period of 2009-2013. From this information there may be a question as to what amounts could remain rentable without causing injury to others in the area or an overall enlargement of the surface water use.

Injury Evaluation: No injury is evident through this lease proposal alone. Proper rental review should protect against injury should the water right be rented. The Hiawatha Canal Company has requested a 20% conveyance be left in the canal to prevent injury, totaling to 0.03 cfs. As the remaining portion of the right is more than 20% the conveyance will be accounted for in the unleased portions.

Enlargement of Use: Because only portions of these rights are offered for lease, a proportional amount of the decreed rate, volume, and acreage will be idled to prevent enlargement of the right. No concerns at this time.

Local Public Interest: Sustainable management of water throughout this basin is in the local public interest. As such, comments will be requested from the staff of Water District 37, and IDWR's Southern Region office.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The beneficial use of irrigation is consistent with the conservation of water throughout the State of Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Water District 37 and IDWR Southern Region comments were requested January 7, 2020. As of the date of this memo there have been no concerns.

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Subject to favorable water district and regional office comments, it is recommended these leases be approved.

Dear Sir or Madam:

The purpose of this letter is to respond generally to water rights being leased to the Water Bank, which are conveyed in the Hiawatha Canal ("Canal") by the Hiawatha Canal Company, a.k.a. The Hiawatha Canal Water Users Association of Lateral or Laterals ("Canal Company"). For the reasons outlined below and on the conditions requested, the Canal has no objection to the aforementioned water rights being placed into the Water Bank.

The Hiawatha Canal Company is concerned about the amount of water being removed from the Canal and placed in the Water Bank by various water right holders. Generally, at this time, the Canal Company does not object to water rights conveyed in the Hiawatha Canal being placed in the Water Bank provided that if the water rights are leased to parties outside of the Canal, then the Water Bank should require twenty-percent (20%) of the right be left in the Canal as conveyance loss. I suggest that the Department place a condition on the leases to this effect.

Providing you some historical perspective, the Canal Company filed for mitigation (conveyance loss) rights in the adjudication for rights that had been forfeited or abandoned out of the Canal. The Department agreed that the conveyance loss in the Canal was twenty-percent (20%), and therefore, entered recommendations accordingly. See e.g., water rights 37-22630, 37-22631, 37-22632 and 37-22633. This conveyance has been recognized by the Idaho Department of Water Resources in similar transfers. Leaving twenty-percent (20%) of the leased rights in the Canal will insure that all rights in the Canal continue to be delivered without injury to water right holders in the Canal.

As a condition of being leased, the Canal Company requests:

1. The Canal Company does not presently object to the aforementioned water rights being placed in the Water Bank, provided that twenty-percent (20%) of the right is left in the Canal as conveyance loss; and

2. The Canal Company would like to be notified if the water rights are eventually released from the Water Bank, or if the Water Rights are being leased again to the Water Bank after the expiration of the lease period.
