Darrell Smith, Jerome, our well driller, has supplied us with information and these forms. He believes a 5-7 $\frac{1}{2}$  H.P. pump will suffice us. It will pump approx. 50 gallon per minute which he thinks we are in our boundaries to ask for.

Mr. Smith is helping us as to how many feet we are allowed between well, house, sewer, ditches, drains, and etc.

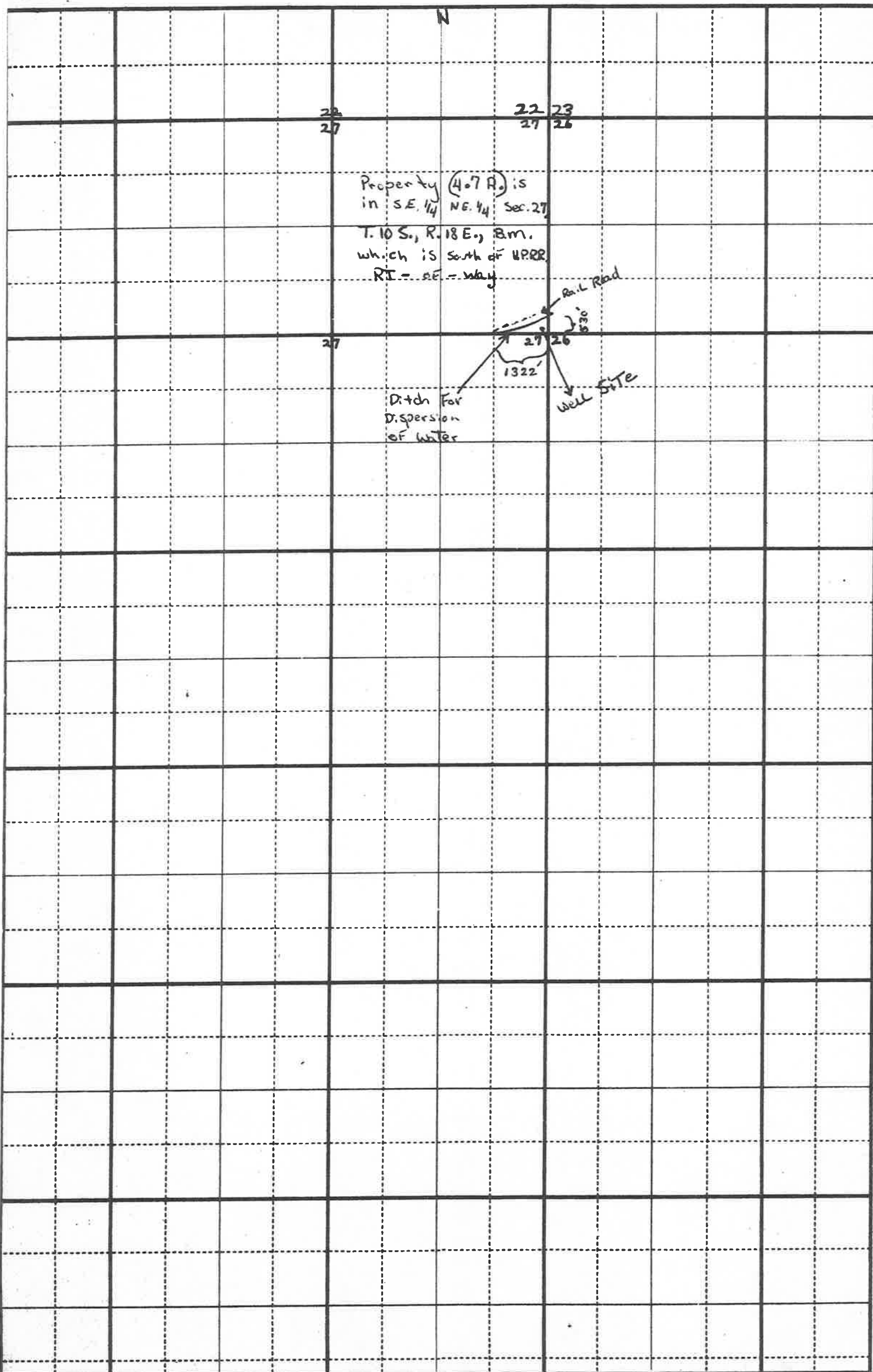
