

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ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that the department has examined this application for temporary approval to use water under the provisions of Section 42-202A, Idaho Code, and has determined that:
A. The application for temporary approval should be denied.
B. The application for temporary approval should be approved, since
1. The temporary approval can be properly administered.
2. Other water sources are not readily available.
3. The approval is in the public interest.
4. The approval will not injure known public values associated with the water source or any known water rights.
This application is therefore hereby:
A. DENIED
B. APPROVED, subject to the following conditions:
1. Diversion and use of water under this approval is subject to all valid existing water rights.
2. The applicant assumes all risk the use of the water under this approval may injure other water rights.
3. This approval authorizes a maximum diversion of O, O+ AF and a maximum rate of diversion of O, O+ cfs.
4. This approval does not grant a right-of-way across the land of another, does not create a continuing right to use the
water and may not be used in connection with a use which requires a continuing water supply.
5. The department may cancel this approval at any time if the department identifies injury to other water rights.
6. This approval does not create a continuing right to use water.
7. The holder of this temporary permit shall not divert at a rate or in a manner that will significantly reduce the flow in the water source or otherwise adversely affect fish, wildlife or other public values.
8. Water intakes should be screened to prevent entrainment or impingement of fish or other aquatic life. The maximum
screen mesh size should be 0.25 inches; approach velocities should not exceed 0.5 ft/second.
9. The Idaho Department of Fish & Game (IDFG) now requires a Special Use Permit if their property is to be used for a
point of diversion. IDFG contact in Coeur d'Alene $\sim 208-769-1414$, and in Lewiston $\sim 208-799-5010$.
10. This approval expires on 8 30, 2014.


DAHO Department of Water Resources General Mapping Tool

Dear Mr. Franklin:

We received your letter requesting our comments on the approval of the temporary water right applications from the Knife River Corporation to draw a total of 0.06 acre-feet of water from the Clearwater River and South Fork Clearwater River for road construction activities. Assuming all federal, state and local permits have been obtained, regulations met, and reviews completed, we offer the following comments.

The section of the Clearwater River at the point of diversion at Turkey Island is included in water body ID 17060306CL002_07 and is currently listed in Category 5 of the Idaho 2010 Integrated Report as not supporting beneficial uses due to dissolved gas supersaturation. The Clearwater River is protected for cold water and salmonid spawning aquatic life, primary contact recreation, and domestic water supply beneficial uses. DEQ believes the flow in the Clearwater River at the point of diversion is significant enough that the beneficial uses should not be impacted by the temporary water appropriation.

Based on the information provided in the application, it is unclear whether Knife River's proposed withdrawal of .02 acre-feet of water is from the South Fork Clearwater River, or from Meadow Creek at the Meadow Creek Bridge. The section of the South Fork Clearwater River at the proposed point of diversion is included in water body ID 17060305CL012_05 and is currently listed in Category 4a of the Idaho 2010 Integrated Report as not supporting beneficial uses due to temperature and sediment. The South Fork Clearwater River is protected for cold water and salmonid spawning aquatic life and primary contact recreation beneficial uses. DEQ believes the flow in the South Fork Clearwater River at this point of diversion is significant enough that the beneficial uses should not be impacted by the temporary water appropriation.

The section of Meadow Creek at the Meadow Creek Bridge is included in water body ID 17060305CL080_03 and is currently listed in Category 4a of the Idaho 2010 Integrated Report as not supporting beneficial uses due to temperature impairment. Meadow Creek is protected for cold water and salmonid spawning and secondary contact recreation beneficial uses. DEQ believes the flow in Meadow Creek at this point of diversion is significant enough that the beneficial uses should not be impacted by the temporary water appropriation.
