CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1. The right holder shall make full beneficial use of all surface water available to the right holder for irrigation of lands within the authorized place of use for this right. The right holder may divert ground water under this right to irrigate land with appurtenant surface water rights when the surface water supply is not reasonably sufficient to irrigate the place of use for this water right or is not available due to drought, curtailment by priority, or the seasonal startup and shutoff or maintenance schedule for canal company deliveries. The right holder shall not divert ground water for irrigation purposes under this right if use of the surface water supply is intentionally discontinued or reduced (for example abandoned, forfeited, sold, disallowed by court decree, or leased to the Water Supply Bank), or is not deliverable due to non-payment of annual assessments, without an approved transfer pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-222 or other Department approval.
- This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor
 exceed a combined annual maximum diversion volume of 828.0 af at the field headgate for the
 place of use.
- 3. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 4.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 4. Use of water from Indian Creek under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 63.
- 5. The right holder shall maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type approved by the Department in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversion(s).
- 6. Stockwater use is for 200 head cattle.
- 7. The quantity of water under this right for stockwater use shall not exceed 13,000 gallons per day.
- 8. The quantity of water under this right consists of 1 cfs from Indian Creek and 2.9 cfs from 9 wells, not to exceed a combined total of 3.68 cfs.
- 9. The quantity of water decreed for this water right for stockwater use is not a determination of historical beneficial use.
- 10. To the extent the source of this water right from Indian Creek includes waste water, the wasting of water may be discontinued at anytime, in compliance with state law.
- 11. The right holder shall accomplish the change authorized by this transfer within one year of the date of this approval.
- 12. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of this transfer is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the transfer.

EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was not held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. <u>It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:</u>

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. Note: the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

- (a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or
- (b) The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.

APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, if this preliminary order becomes final, any party aggrieved by the final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal the final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

The appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of this preliminary order becoming final. See section 67-5273, Idaho Code. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.

The purpose of this transfer is to change the point of diversion from Indian Creek located in the SWNE 1/4 1/4 of Sec 5, Twp 02N, Rge 01W to a point of diversion from Indian Creek in the NENW 1/4 1/4 of Sec 5, Twp 02N, Rge 01W.

The site is located just west of the Ridenbaugh Canal and one mile east of the Greenhurst Elementary School in Nampa ID.

Summary of Information Submitted

Authority to File: The applicant is the current water right holder of record for the water right involved in this transfer application. Applicant owns the property appurtenant to the place of use (POU) and proposed point of diversion (POD). Louis P. Murgoitio and Victorina M. Murgoitio have authority to sign on behalf of V & L Ranches, LLC for the application.

Water Right Validity:

Water right 63-2758B is a decreed right, decreed January 14, 2009. Department records show that the right is valid and has not been lost by forfeiture or partial forfeiture. Recent beneficial use within the previous, consecutive, five-year period was confirmed via aerial photography, and GIS ArcMap tools. No defense of forfeiture is needed.

Overlap Analysis:

Overlap analysis of the existing POD and the proposed POD demonstrate no existing or potential POD overlap. Overlap analysis of the POU which is not proposed to change shows overlapping Nampa Meridian Irrigation District water for the POU from whom the applicant does receive water for the POU.

Injury to Other Water Rights:

Injury to other water rights is not likely as a result of this transfer. The application does not intend to increase the number of acres irrigated or the amount of water to be diverted. The transfer proposes moving the POD just downstream on Indian creek and there are no existing water right POD's between the existing and proposed POD for right 63-2758B. Thus, the amount of water available to other water rights is not expected to be reduced as a result of this right's POD on Indian Creek being moved. Because the water right changes proposed through this transfer application do not appear to change the effect on the original or hydraulically connected water source or affect other water rights, review of the transfer application found no cause to require public notice. Comments from the watermaster were still sought; the watermaster does not oppose the approval of this application as long as standard watermaster conditions are met and lockable controlling works and a measuring device are installed.

Enlargement of Use:

The transfer proposed does not increase the amount of water that has been historically used by changing the intended POD. There is no increase to diversion rate, or volume proposed by this transfer. The period of use will not be changed as a result of this transfer. The nature of use of the water right will not be altered by this transfer. For these reasons, an enlargement of use is not anticipated as a result of this transfer.

Local Public Interest:

There are no anticipated impacts to recreation, fish, or wildlife as a result of this transfer complies with applicable water and hazardous substance standards designed to protect the public water resource. The proposed transfer would comply with local and state government regulations, zoning ordinances, and policies. This transfer is compatible with the objectives and policies of the State Water Plan. For these reasons, this transfer should be considered in favor of local public interest.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The application proposes beneficial use consistent with conservation of water resources in Idaho.

The application is consistent with criteria of I. C. § 42-222 and should be processed.

Discussion

During review it became apparent that 63-2758B was decreed without describing a rate or volume for the stockwater use of the right. The applicant was contacted to ask if they would like keep the stockwater element of the right undefined or if they would like IDWR to better describe the elements of the right. Vicki Murgotio informed me that she would prefer to have the stockwater use defined with a rate and volume. Thus, I added a non-cumulative 0.05 cfs rate to the right. This should not impose more or less than what the right was decreed for by the adjudication court. If anything it is likely reducing/limiting the stockwater use and should therefore not be considered an enlargement or pose any potential injury to existing rights. Conditions 943, WB7, R05, R43, and R61 were added to the right. Additionally standard Transfer conditions T07, T08, and T19 were added and conditions C05 and C18 were removed.
