The water rights were assigned to the total acreage held. That acreage is approximately 113 acres. I believe it reasonable to have the water rights distributed according to acreage proportions.

The pipeline referred to in the Application For Transfer # 84175 Page 2 under 5. b. installed in the late 1960,s has a tributary line running to the north side of my property intended for irrigation of my property.

NOTE:


