- Remarks This is a countywide request as many of our road construction & maintenance projects are  
ongoing throughout the summer and typically last for 1-2 days. Our road maintenance encompasses  
the whole county and is performed as-needed. We try to time our maintenance with the weather to  
utilize the natural moisture, however during the dry season we often need supplement this with  
additional water.
