 6. This approval does not create a continuing right to use water.
 7. The holder of this temporary permit shall not divert at a rate or in a manner that will significantly reduce the flow in the water source or otherwise adversely affect fish, wildlife or other public values.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

7. (revised from page 2)

The holder of this temporary permit shall not divert at a rate or in a manner that will significantly reduce the flow in the water source or otherwise adversely affect fish, wildlife or other public values. At no time shall this diversion exceed 25% of the total creek flow.

10. ¼ inch mesh screen shall be installed on the pump intake.

11. Direct discharge of waste water/slurry into rivers, creeks or streams is not authorized.

12. The water use approved herein shall conform to the terms of the Forest Service approved Plan of Operations for this location – Nez Perce/Clearwater National Forest, Marty Jones.
