- Diversion must be screened to meet IDF&G requirements. Please call 208-756-6022 for specifications.
- The pump placement in the stream shall be away from potential fish refugia like stream banks with overhanging vegetation or accumulated large woody debris.
- All equipment involved with transporting water shall be treated/sterilized to avoid spread of invasive aquatic species prior to use. If equipment involved with transporting water has been moved into Idaho from another state (Particularly from NV, CO, UT, AZ, CA or TX) contact ISDA for an inspection. We recommend contacting ISDA (Amy Ferriter @ 208-332-8686) for treatment recommendations.



RE: Application for Temporary Approval of Water Appropriation

Application proposes to divert up to approximately 0.077 AF per day with a maximum volume of 5 AF for drilling test holes for a highway construction project on Hwy 75 over a period of 62 days (August 1 – October 1). Places of use are located in Twp 06N Rng 14E Sections 1 & 2, and Twp 06N Rng 15E Sections 6 & 7. The point of diversion is located in Twp 06N Rge 14E S3 SENE1/4 (QQ as computed by IDWR; the most recent BLM survey, approved in 2006, lists the QQ as a non-surveyed protracted block and applicant listed it as Govt Lot 4). A copy of this application was forwarded to Bob Esselman, Idaho Department of Fish and Game, Salmon Office and Nick Miller, Watermaster of Water District 170, for comments and concerns. Recommend conditioning this permit with standard Fish and Game screening requirements and that all equipment involved with transporting water be treated/sterilized to avoid the spread of invasive aquatic species prior to use.
