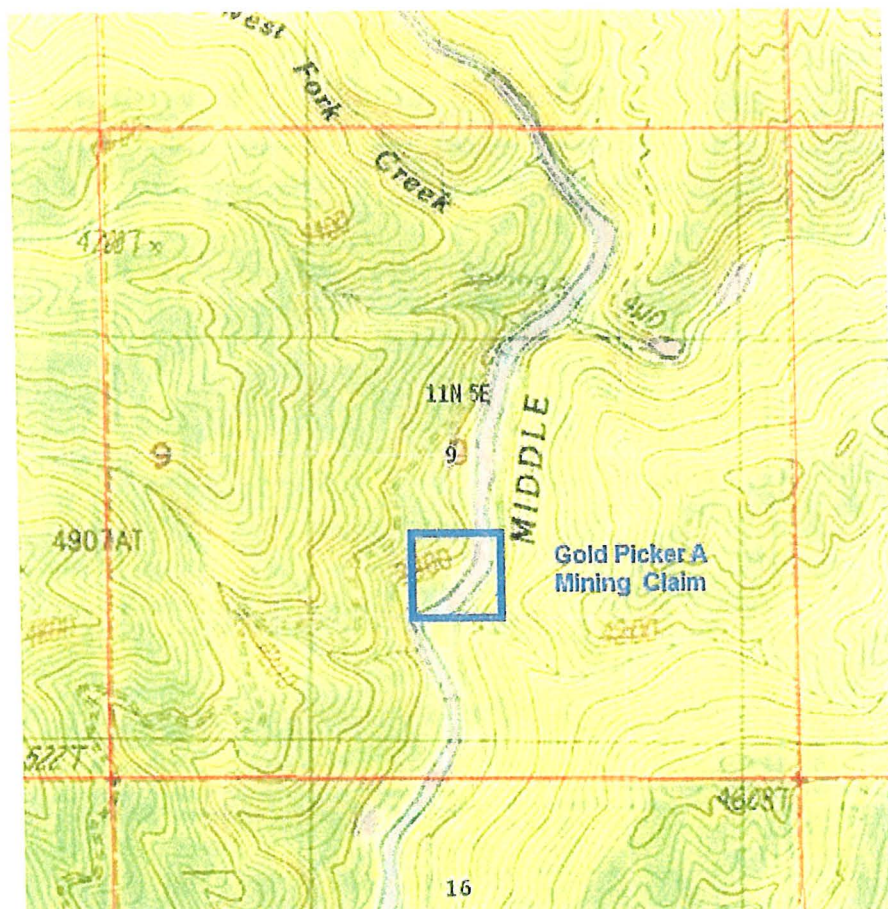

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

10. ¼ inch mesh screen shall be installed on the pump intake.
11. Direct discharge of waste water/slurry into rivers, creeks or streams is not authorized.
12. The water use approved herein shall conform to the terms of Forest Service requirements, if any, for use on public land.
13. Use of water under this approval is limited to the Gold Picker Mining Claim located in T11N, R5E, Section 9 per attached map.
14. Mitigation for water losses will be the rental of 2.0 acre-feet of water from the Payette River Rental Pool. Please submit attached rental agreement form to Ron Shurtleff, Watermaster (see form for contact information).
