RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements
 of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not
 preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application
 process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate diversion of water if the Director determines there is not a sufficient water supply for the priority of the right or portion thereof being rented.
- 9. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.

WATER SUPPLY BANK RENTAL AGREEMENT No. 371

- 10. Prior to December 31 of each year, the Board may review this rental agreement to determine whether it is consistent with the management plan that may be approved for the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer Ground Water Management Area ("ESPA GWMA Plan") pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-233b. The Board may cancel this rental agreement if the Board determines it is not consistent with the ESPA GWMA plan. If this rental agreement is canceled, the cancellation shall not take effect until December 31 of the year in which the rental agreement is canceled.
- 11. This rental does not grant any right-of-way or easement to use the diversion works or conveyance works of another party.
- 12. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.
- 13. Use of water under this agreement will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 120.
- 14. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 15. Prior to the diversion and use of water under Rental Agreement 371, renter shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device(s) at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications, or shall obtain an approved variance from the Department to determine the amount of water diverted from power records or to maintain an existing measuring device.
- 16. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1412(6), the water rights rented under this agreement are subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.

A rental fee of \$3,162.00 was calculated based on the current rental rate of \$20.00 per acre-foot times a diversion volume of 160 acre-feet.

Please send a check for \$3,162.00 made payable to the Idaho Department of Water Resources, together with the signed rental agreement, within 14 days so I can complete processing.

Pursuant to the Water Supply Bank Rules, 90% or \$2845.80 of the rental fee will be paid to the lessor(s) and 10% or \$316.20 will be retained by the Department to offset administrative costs.

Re: Water Supply Bank Rental Application 1461

Purpose/Narrative: The rental application was received September 9, 2019 to rent water for the irrigation of a potato farm. Per the information provided, canal water is available however the applicant stated that it is more beneficial to use groundwater through a pivot system to irrigate rather than handlines from the canal. The acreage requested by this rental is in response to an NOV received February 1, 2018 (No. E2018-1273) for unauthorized water use.

The rental is also in response to an NOV issued to Mr. Williams by IDWR for the irrigation of acreage not covered by a water right. It was determined that, while 38 acres were requested, 40 acres are being irrigated with Mr. Williams' pivot system. As such, the rental amount will be increased to 40 acres to avoid another NOV for unauthorized irrigation.

The groundwater well proposed for the rental location also authorizes diversion of water rights 35-2710 & 35-7223, which are used to irrigate the other three qq's of the SE quarter.

Authority to File: The application was submitted for Jim Williams by Alan Jackson, District Manager of the Bingham Ground Water District. Mr. Williams is the property owner for the acreage being covered by the rental. No concerns about the authority to file at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water rights requested are valid and currently in the bank for longer than the requested duration for this rental. There are no ground water rights appurtenant to the rental place of use, no concerns at this time.

Injury Evaluation: ESPA modeling was provided by the applicant as the rental place of use and rights being requested are both within the ESPA management area. No mitigation is required through this rental and no injury is apparent. No concerns at this time.

Enlargement of Use: Combined limit restrictions for the rights being requested will be enforced to prevent any possible enlargement. The water rights being used in conjunctions with the rental, 35-2710 & 35-7223, authorize per acre rates and volumes of 0.02 cfs/ac and 4.0 af/ac as do the rights being rented. No concerns at this time. Conditions will also be added to the contract in line with the proper management of ESPA resources.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the rental.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster and IDWR Eastern Region comments were requested January 29, 2020.

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Bank staff recommend the approval of this rental for Mr. Williams through 2021.
