Please be advised THE PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO THE EFFECTIVE DATES AND CONDITIONS STATED ON PAGE TWO OF THE APPLICATION. Condition #12 requires the purchase (lease) of storage water from the Boise River Rental Pool to provide mitigation to senior Boise River water right holders for injury.

Our area is experiencing a very low mountain snow pack this season. Due to low river and creek natural flows and demand for irrigation water, much of the storage water in the rental pool has been rented. Storage water is rented on a first come basis.
