

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

Dear Mr. Franklin:

We received your request for our comments on the approval of an application for a temporary water appropriation to withdraw a total of 0.84 acre feet of water at 50 gallons per minute, with a maximum daily volume of 0.0092 acre feet from points of diversion on Crooked River, the South Fork Clearwater River near Elk City, and Big Creek a tributary to the Salmon River. The appropriated water will be used for supporting exploration core drilling at numerous sites. We assume the water will be obtained using a potable water pump and transported to drill sites using a truck mounted tank. We also assume all federal, state and local permits have been obtained, regulations met, and the exploration and mining plan of operation does not include a discharge to waters of the State.

Big Creek is in water body ID17060207SL069 and is currently listed in in Category 2 of the Idaho 2010 Integrated Report as supporting its beneficial uses. Crooked River and the South Fork Clearwater River are included in water bodies ID17060305CL031, ID17060305CL032, ID17060305CL036 and are currently listed in Category 4a having a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) allocation for sediment and temperature. The TMDL is a pollution management plan that calculates the maximum amount of a pollutant allowed in the creek based on the volume or flow of water in the creek. Reduction in flow in these waters can cause pollutant increases that exceed the total maximum daily load and Idaho water quality standards.

Based on the information included in the TMDL, available flow information for these water bodies, and the nature of the requested diversions we believe the requested withdrawals can be made from Big Creek, Crooked River, or the South Fork Clearwater River without an impact to water quality if existing access points are used, discharge to state waters does not occur, and riparian vegetation is not disturbed.
