 2. The applicant assumes all risk the use of the water under this approval may injure other water rights.
 3. This approval authorizes a maximum diversion of 1.0 AF and a maximum rate of diversion of 50 cfs/gpm
 4. This approval does not grant a right-of-way across the land of another, does not create a continuing right to use the water and may not be used in connection with a use which requires a continuing water supply.
 5. The department may cancel this approval at any time if the department identifies injury to other water rights.
 6. This approval expires on October 30, 2013.
 7. This approval does not create a continuing right to use water.
 8. The holder of this temporary permit shall not divert at a rate or in a manner that will significantly reduce the flow in the water source or otherwise adversely affect fish, wildlife or other public values. At no time shall this diversion exceed 25% of the total creek flow.
 9. ¼ inch mesh screen shall be installed on the pump intake
 10. Direct discharge of waste water/slurry into rivers, creeks, or streams is not authorized.
 11. The water use approved herein is subject to and shall conform to the terms of the State of Idaho Exploration Certificate--Operations and Rules for this location.
 12. Mitigation for water losses will be the rental of 1.0 acre foot of water from the Boise River Rental Pool, contact Rex Barrie, Watermaster, phone 208-908-5480
