Dear Ms. Weidemier:

You recently contacted our office regarding any concerns our Department may have regarding the addition of a Bully Barn on your property located at 1946 E 3950 N in Twin Falls County, PARCEL NO. RP10S15E114200 for the purpose of a beauty salon. You indicated that there is an existing domestic well on the property that will be used to provide water to the new facility. Upon review, IDWR would like to make the following comments for your consideration:

Review of IDWR records indicates that there is one domestic and stock water right (47-13344) in the name of John Lorain appurtenant to the property. I have included a copy of the proof report of this water right for your reference. Note that the groundwater right allows for the diversion of 0.06 cfs for domestic purposes and ½ acre of irrigation not to exceed 13,000 gallons per day. IDWR has no concerns with your proposal, as long as the use of water from the well does not exceed the limits described on this water right. Also note that a change of ownership for this water right appears to be needed. I have enclosed an application for change of ownership as well.

In closing the Department has no objections to the proposed facility. If you have any questions, or if you need any further assistance, feel free to contact me 208-316-0809.
