






EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. <u>It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:</u>

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. Note: the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

Summary of Application Proposal

Narrative: Transfer 83238 proposes to change a diversion point for water right 57-89 and add a diversion point for water rights 57-104, 57-116, 57-120, 57-127, 57-149, 57-2104, 57-89, and 57-95. Water right 57-89 is the only POD to be changed in order to correct an error in the original quarter-quarter which should read NWNE not NWSE. The applicant lists two existing diversions a lower diversion at SENWNE sec. 3 05S01E (about 0.25 miles upstream of new diversion) and an upper diversion at SESESW sec. 3 05S01E (1.0 miles upstream of new diversion). The new diversion is approximately 6.7 miles upstream from the confluence of Castle Creek with the Snake River (River mile 471.2). The applicant proposes to pump from the added POD in SESE sec.34 05S01E to irrigate about 145 acres. Water will be used at the current place of use roughly 18 miles southeast of Murphy, Idaho along the Oreana Loop Road.

Location of Application Proposal: The proposed change is located approximately 18 miles southeast of Murphy, Idaho in Owyhee County.

Contact persons for the application are Calvin and Susie Low, (208) 834-2384.

Summary of Information Submitted

Authority to File: The application was filed in the names of Calvin and Susie Low residing at 21101 Oreana Loop Rd, Murphy, ID 83650. All water rights listed above were found to be in the name of Calvin D and Susie F Low of the same address. Pertinent tax parcel information (RP05S01E030001, RP04S01E341800, RP04S01E354200) obtained by the Department and dated 6/13/2019 show the property jointly owned by Cal and Susie Low. Both the proposed POD and the current POU are located on this property.

Water Right Validity/Historical Beneficial Use: Water rights 57-104, 57-116, 57-120, 57-127, 57-149, 57-2104, 57-89, and 57-95 are irrigation rights from Castle Creek tributary to the Snake River decreed on 11/3/2000. Aerial imagery indicates evidence of irrigation at the place of use. In recent years at least two pivot sprinkler systems have been installed which in turn has made minor changes in the shape of the acreages put to beneficial use. However, section 35 SWNW, 7 acres and NWSW, 1.2 acres, have areas which show no evidence of irrigation. Also, section 3 NENE Lot 1 was decreed for 12 acres but only 9.3 acres had evidence of irrigation, a 2.7 acre deficit. Overall, the beneficial use analysis resulted in evidence for 142.1 acres of the original decree of 145 acres.

An email with a letter attached was sent by IDWR to the applicants on May 10, 2019 requesting information regarding the potential partial forfeiture of the water rights. Scott King, SPF Water Engineering responded on May 20, 2019 confirmed that "the swale area that used to not be purposely irrigated is now under the pivot and is irrigated." Also, "the areas in SWNW and NWSW Section 35…are not irrigated." The swale area in the NESE of Section 34 that is covered by the pivot occupies approximately 4.2 acres. The long thin area split between SWNW and NWSW of Section 35 covers about 5.0 acres.

The representative's confirmation with the applicant of the non-irrigated acres in the area split between SWNW and NWSW of Section 35 was considered validity for a partial forfeiture of those portions of the associated water rights.

Further, areas under pivot irrigation in the swale area in the NESE of Section 34 were considered valid and conditioned according to the redefinition of those elements. POU shapefiles were updated consequently to reflect the pattern of irrigation observed under beneficial use, resulting in a POU of 142.1 acres.

Considering that the rate diverted from each right is at the rate limit and since each senior right never exceeded the rate per acre limit (either 0.02 or 0.021 cfs/acre) so that by reducing the most junior right by 0.06 cfs the decreed rate/acre could be maintained. Therefore, water right 57-2104 with a 1920 priority date was reduced from 1.28 to 1.22 cfs (-0.06 cfs). The total diversion rates went from 3.08 to 3.02 cfs.

Overlap Analysis: Overlap analysis show the water rights included in this transfer, 57-89, 57-95, 57-104, 57-116, 57-120, 57-127, 57-149, 57-2104, all share the same points of diversion and place of use with a combined use limited to 145 acres. A comment in the proof reports, states that 0.18 cfs of right no. 57-2104 is limited to use for conveyance losses in delivery of the other rights. A notable overlap of the transfer is water right 57-11874. This active permit is in the name of the Low's with a 2016 priority date. It has a rate of 2.68 cfs from supplemental groundwater for 135 acres. It overlaps acres in sections 34 and 35. The water right has a proof date of 2022.

Injury to Other Water Rights: None anticipated, though there are other surface water diversions downstream of the current POD and the new POD location including 57-123 (1897) and 57-220B (1910) belonging to King and 57-12005 (2019) belonging to Low. There is no information to suggest this is a gaining or losing reach of the river. Aerial imagery suggests this ditch and associated land have not been irrigated and priority dates show these to be younger rights.

Enlargement of Use: IDWR's Administrator's Memorandum 24 Transfer Processing Policies & Procedures section 5d, enlargement of use, elicits a concern with multiple points of diversion in item 10, enhancing water supply. Item 10 states, "an application for transfer, which proposes to change a point of diversion from a surface water source to a new location where the water available is greater or more reliable, such as moving from the tributary of a stream downstream to the mainstem of the stream, is presumed to enlarge the water right, unless the proposed change is subject to conditions limiting diversion of water at the proposed new point of diversion to times when water is available and in priority at the original point of diversion."

There is no evidence that the new point of diversion will cause enlargement by enhancing supply.

Local Public Interest: No issues were identified. It is within the local public interest to allow private properties to develop their property and use their water rights to the fullest extent which in turn benefits the public at large. It is within the local public interest to allow the change in POD.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The application proposes beneficial use consistent with conservation of water resources in Idaho by continuing to irrigate agricultural lands.

Summary of Application Approval / Denial

Discussion

As a result of forfeiture analysis, POU shapefiles were updated accordingly to reflect the pattern of irrigation observed under beneficial use, resulting in a POU of 142.1 acres. Rates were reduced proportionally to 3.02 cfs.

Conditions

If approved the following changes should be made to the conditions of water right nos. 57-89, 57-95, 57-104, 57-116, 57-120, 57-127, 57-149, 57-2104.

• X35- Rights 57-89, 57-95, 57-104, 57-116, 57-120, 57-127, 57-149 and 57-2104 when combined shall not exceed a total irrigation of 142.1 acres.

Assuming no other information contradicts the above analysis, the application can be approved as reflected by the draft approval.

The application is consistent with criteria of I. C. § 42-222 and should be processed.
