OF INTERIOR, BUREAU OF LAND MGMT. of BOISE, IDAHO, has complied with the terms and conditions of the permit issued pursuant to Application for Permit dated July 21, 1983, and has submitted proof to the Department of Water Resources on May 16, 1984, that water has been applied to a beneficial use; an examination by the Department indicates that the works have a capacity of 0.02 cfs of water from a spring tributary to Dry Hollow and that a water right has been established as follows:
