IN THE MATTER OF VOIDING APPLICATION FOR PERMIT
NO. 72-7296 IN THE NAME OF FIRST EAGLE CORP.

WHEREAS, on June 30, 1983, First Eagle Corporation applied to the Department of Water Resources for a permit to appropriate 1.00 cubic feet per second from Copper Creek to be diverted within the NE1/4NW1/4, Sec. 30, Twp. 11N, Rge. 14E, B.M., Custer County, to be used for mining and domestic purposes; and,

WHEREAS, on September 15 and 22, 1983, notice of this application was published in the Challis Messenger, a newspaper published in Challis, Idaho; and,

WHEREAS, on September 30, 1983, the Department received a protest against the granting of the application from the United States Forest Service; and,

WHEREAS, on a hearing in this matter was held on June 21, 1984 at Challis, Idaho at which time the applicant failed to appear; and,

WHEREAS, on July 11, 1984, the Department issued an Order to Show Cause on or before July 31, 1984, why the application should not be voided for failure of the applicant to appear at the conference and/or hearing; and,

WHEREAS, applicant failed to respond and did not show cause why he did not appear at the hearing or why the application should not be voided;

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED that Application for Permit No. 72-7296 be VOIDED.

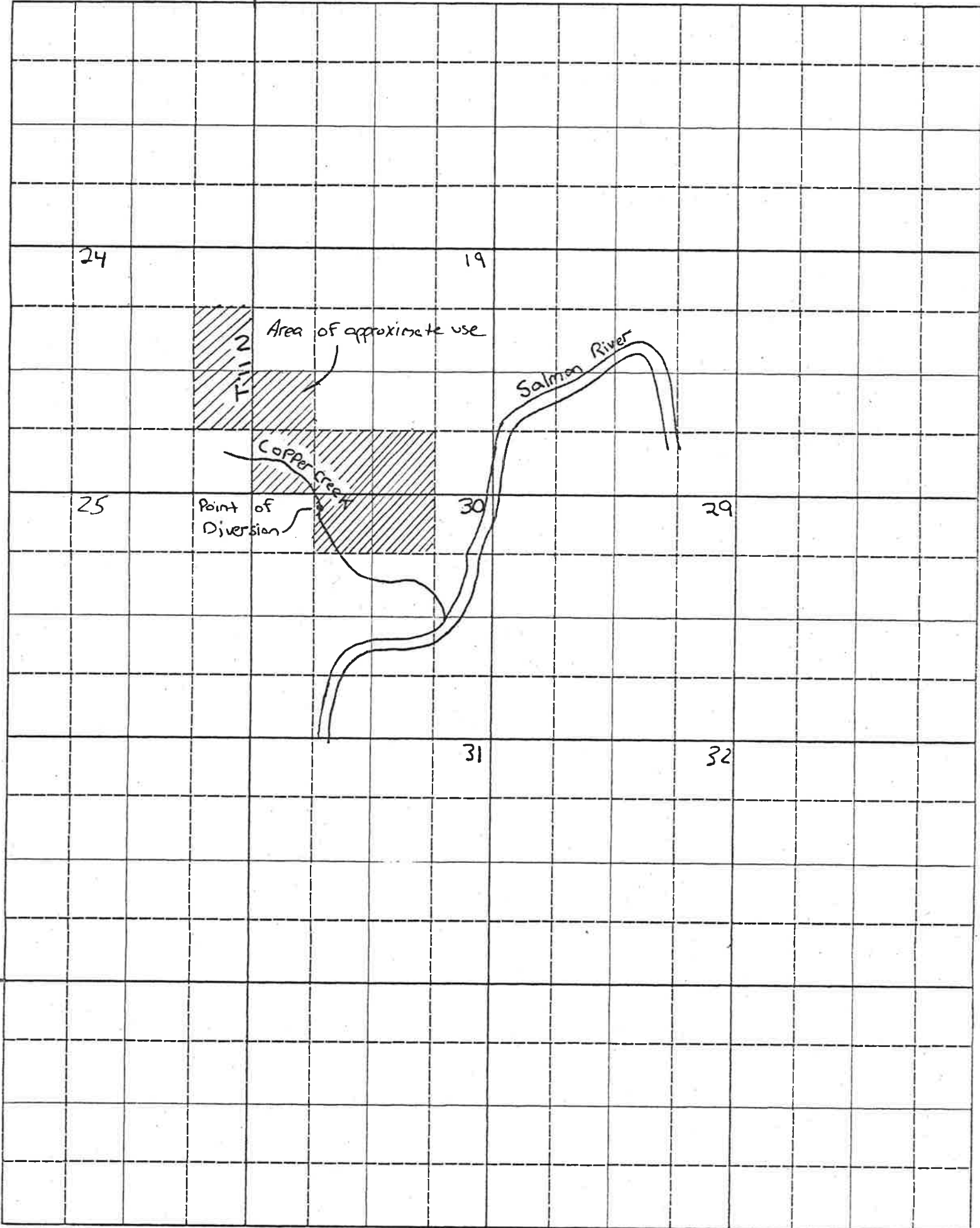
