RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- 2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. Rights 63-34641 and 63-34642 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.05 cfs, a total annual maximum diversion volume of 20.1 af at the field headgate, and the irrigation of 4.6 acres.
- 10. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.


- 11. The period of use for the irrigation described under water right 63-34642 in this approval may be extended to a beginning date of 3/1 and an ending date of 11/15 provided that beneficial use of the water can be shown and other elements of the right are not exceeded. The use of water before 4/1 and after 10/15 is subordinate to all water rights having no subordinated early or late irrigation use and a priority date earlier than 5/2/2008.
- 12. Place of use is located within Lot 7, Blk. 2, Deersky Ranch Subdivision.
- 13. Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.
- 14. Point of diversion is located within Lot 7, Blk. 2, Deersky Ranch Subdivision.
- 15. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.





Re: Water Supply Bank Rental Application 1704

Purpose/Narrative: An application was received April 20, 2020 on behalf of the Randy and Leslie Stewart Living Trust requesting a rental of their own water rights. Prior to the Stewarts taking ownership of the water rights, they were leased to the Bank as part of the Deersky Ranch subdivision (contract 313), located south of Lake Lowell in Canyon County. Through this rental the applicants seek supplement their existing rental using their own water to use at the decreed place of use. While the Trust is able to request their water rights be removed from the Bank, it has been administratively easier for the Stewarts to rent their own water rights through the expiration of the lease contract at which point they will be released from the Bank.

Authority to File: The application was signed by Randy Stewart on behalf of the Randy and Leslie Stewart Living Trust. The applications we prepared and submitted by their representative at SPF Water Engineering. No concerns at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water rights being requested are currently leased to the Bank and are available for rental through the end of 2020. No concerns at this time.

Injury Evaluation: No injury is apparent through the rental as the Stewarts intend to use the water rights at their intended place of use. A portion of the water right totals will remain in the Bank to allocate for hardscape that cannot be irrigated.

Enlargement of Use: no enlargement is evident as the Trust has requested to rent only the portions allocated to their parcel through the ownership change and split of the parent water right.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the rental.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster for District 37 and IDWR Western Region comments were requested

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Bank staff recommend the approval of this rental for a single year through the end of 2020.
