Dear Mr. Wood:

The department has reviewed the request for extension of time which you submitted in connection with the above referenced permit. In the request, you state that you need additional time to develop a water right since the U. S. Forest Service has not given their approval to your project.

A review of the water right file shows that the permit was issued in February 1983 and that the department has already granted one extension of time.

In order to consider the pending extension request, you need to provide additional evidence to show the amount of time you allegedly have been delayed by the Forest Service. The information which you provided with the extension request shows that on October 5, 1989, you submitted a proposal to the Forest Service. On November 2, 1989, the Forest Service responded to you and specifically advised of additional information you needed to submit to them before your proposed operating plan could be further considered. The Forest Service told me today that you have not yet responded to their November 2, 1989 letter.

The information you have provided with the extension request does not justify approval of the request. If you have other information to show there has been additional delay attributable to the Forest Service or other governmental agency, please provide it to the department within thirty (30) days. If you do not timely submit the requested information or if the information is insufficient to justify approval of the extension request, the department will deny the request.

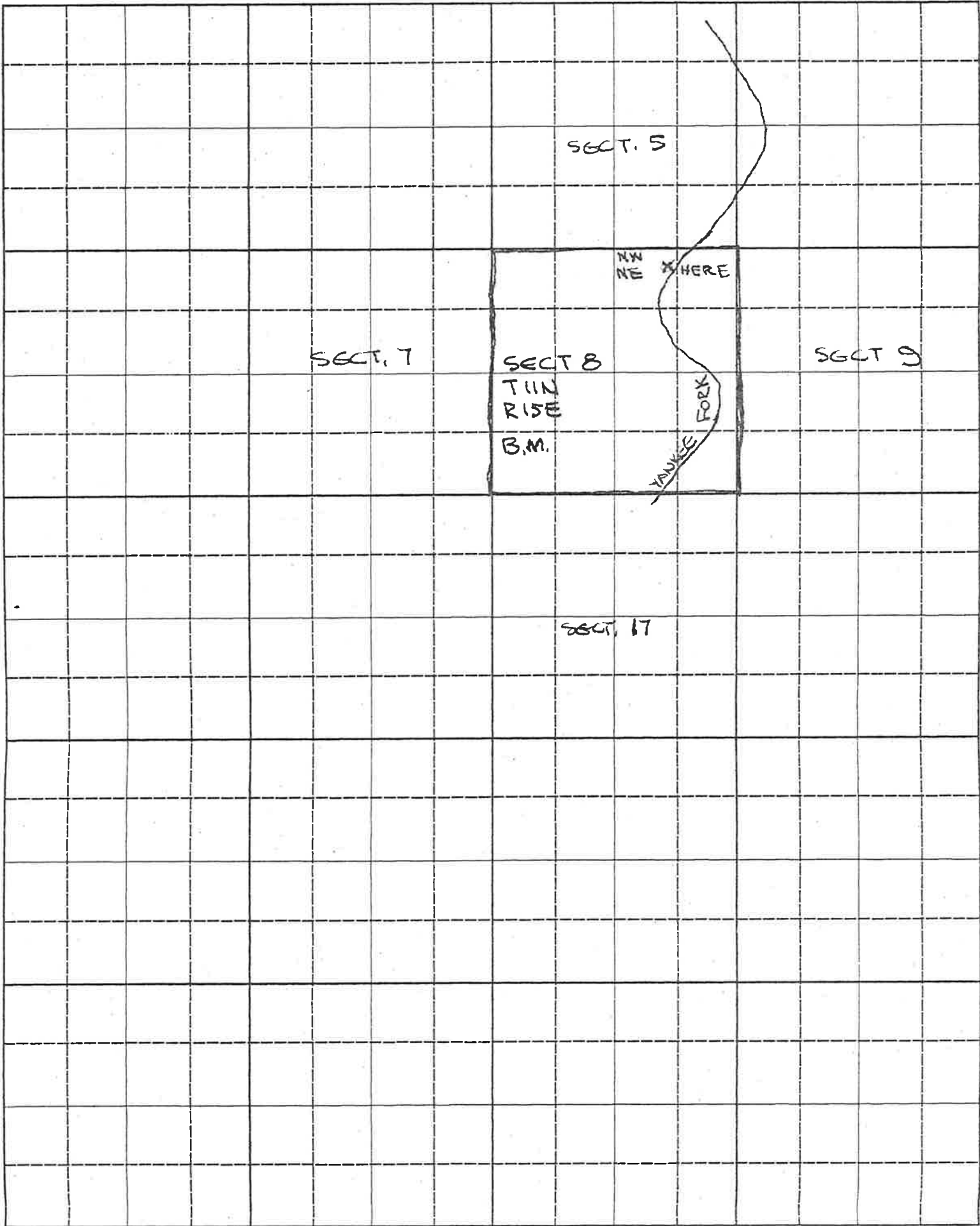

ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 72-7231, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.
- b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before February 1, 1988.
- c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
- d. Other:

Permit holder shall commence the excavation or construction of diverting works within one year of the date this permit is issued and shall proceed diligently until the project is complete.

An access port or other device as specified by the Department shall be installed by the permit holder to provide for the installation of measuring equipment and the determination of the rate of diversion by the Department.

In the event that water used under this permit should be discharged into a natural channel, settling ponds will be required which are capable of reducing the silt load to such a level that the quality of the water would not be impaired for other beneficial uses.

The issuance of this permit in no way grants any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
