RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- 2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.



- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 3.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 10. Use of water under this agreement may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No 37.
- 11. Prior to diversion of water under this right, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works.
- 12. Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.
- 13. This agreement does not grant any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.



I have enclosed a Water Supply Bank Rental Agreement for your review and signature. Re: Water Supply Bank Rental Application 1717

Purpose/Narrative: An application was received by the Department from Mr. Dan Brown requesting a rental of Big Wood surface water for 2020 and 2021. This application is a repeat of prior applications submitted by Mr. Brown beginning in 2014, requesting a rental of water rights with an 1883 priority date. While there are water rights appurtenant to Brown Ranch's permissible place of use, they are often out of priority by the beginning of the summer months. The purpose of this rental is to supplement Mr. Brown's water right portfolio such that he is able to irrigate through the summer.

In the application paperwork Mr. Brown had indicated that he was not interested in water rights older than 1883 and would like to rent a total of 533.5 acres. Per a phone conversation with Mr. Brown, 149 specific acres were identified in Section 14 of their permissible place of use with a rate of 3.4 cfs with approximately 500 acre-feet.

Authority to File: Mr. Dan Brown prepared and submitted the application on behalf of Brown Ranch Inc. Review of IDSOS data indicates Mr. Brown is the registered agent for the corporation. No concerns at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water rights being used to facilitate this rental are currently leased to the Bank through 2021 and are available for rent. No concerns at this time.

Injury Evaluation: During the review of Brown Ranch's 2017 rental application it was determined by Mike McVay of IDWR's Hydrology section that the reach was a "losing reach". As such, a 15% reduction was applied to the agreement to reduce the possibility of water users along the Big Wood River. This same reduction will be added to this agreement to reduce the possibility of injury. Further, because the rental will use water rights delivered down the Hiawatha, the 20% conveyance will also be observed for those rights.

Enlargement of Use: No enlargement is evident though the rental as Mr. Brown is seeking to supplement his existing portfolio. Conditions will be added to the approval document to align the rental with the area headgate standard and duty of water.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the rental.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster and IDWR Southern Region comments were requested on

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Bank staff recommend the approval of this application for Brown Ranch for a single year, through the end of 2020.
