1. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before **December 1, 1990.**
2. Subject to all prior water rights.
3. Permit holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Section 42-235, Idaho Code.
4. Prior to the diversion of water under this permit a flow measurement port or other device as specified by the Department shall be installed to provide for the installation of measuring equipment and the determination of the rate of diversion by the Department.
5. The rate of diversion of water for irrigation under this permit and all other water rights on the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
6. The maximum rate of diversion under this permit for irrigation purposes shall not exceed 2.44 cfs.



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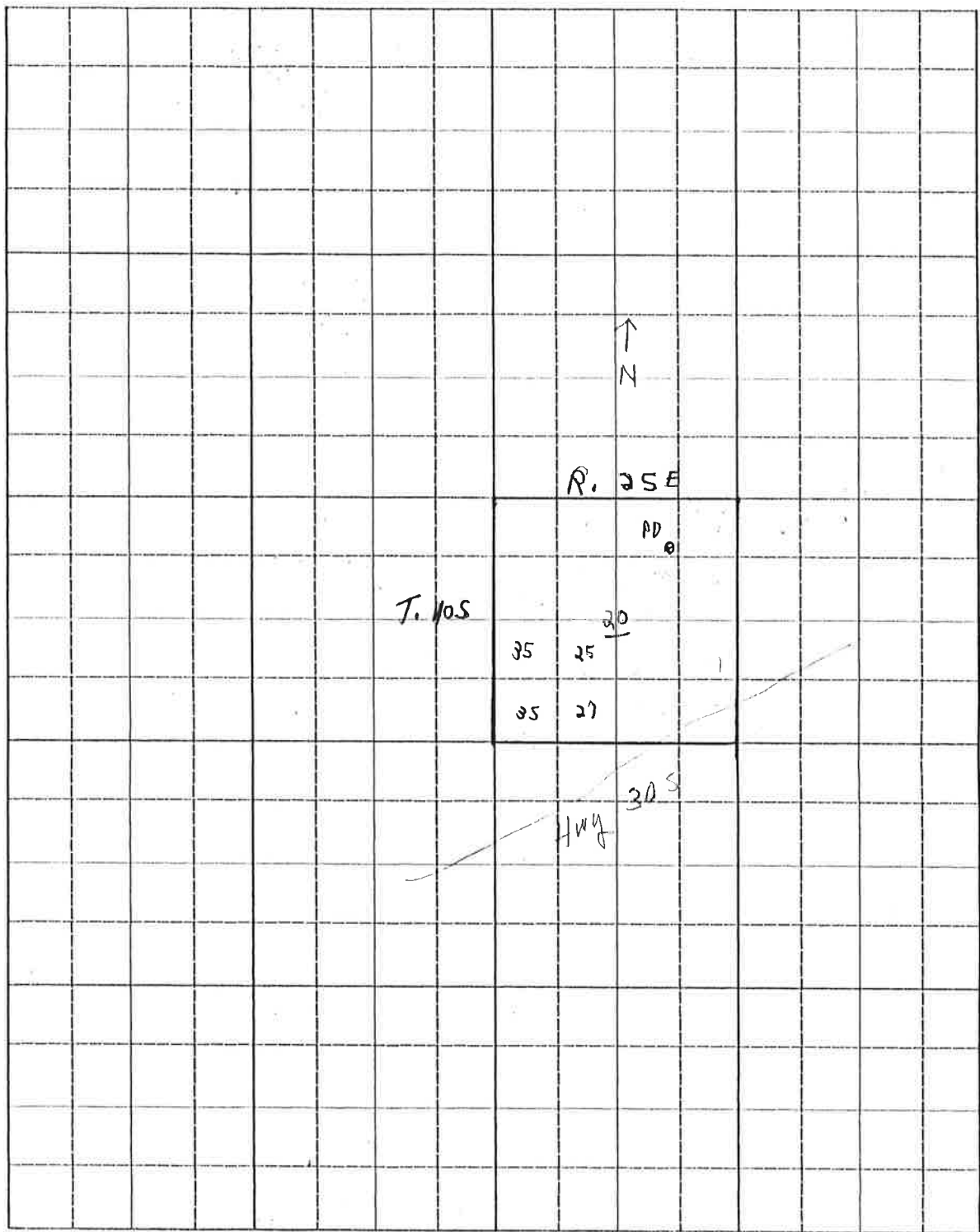
