Dear Mr. Woods:

The department has reviewed your letter dated October 13, 1992, in connection with the order of the department dated September 22, 1992 which voided permit no. 01-7077. The department will consider your letter as a request for hearing as provided in Section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code.

The department voided the permit since information in the file appears to show that water was not diverted and beneficially used during the authorized permit period which started on February 16, 1988 when the permit was approved and ended on September 25, 1990 when you submitted "proof of beneficial use" of the water. Proof of beneficial use is your statement that you have diverted and beneficially used water as authorized by your permit.

If you have sufficient evidence to show that you have diverted and beneficially used water during the authorized period, please promptly provide it to the department. A sufficient showing will be reason to reinstate the permit. If the department does not hear from you within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, we will schedule a hearing in the matter.
