**Dear Concerned Parties:** 

Our office received three protests with the required fee on June 23, 2020. The protests were received and the fees paid after the prescribed date in the notice of June 22, 2020, therefore we must reject your protests (copies enclosed).

Pursuant to: Title 42-203A (emphasis added)

(4) Any person, firm, association or corporation concerned in any such application may, within the time allowed in the notice of application, file with said director of the department of water resources a written protest, together with the statutory filing fee as provided in section 42-221, Idaho Code, against the approval of such application, which protest shall state the name and address of protestant and shall be signed by him or by his agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth his objections to the approval of such application.

(If you need a copy of the full statute, please contact this office. Idaho Statutes are also available on the internet by using the electronic address: https://legislature.idaho.gov/statutesrules/idstat/Title42/T42CH2/).

One other protest was filed on the application. In lieu of the protest you may request IDWR to apply the fee already paid toward granting you permission to participate as an Intervenor in this matter. An Intervenor can participate in the settlement conferences and

the hearing, if one is held. Intervenors have different limited roles in the process as compared to Protestants, but will be notified of dates and times of meetings and would have a "seat at the table". **Please respond within 21 days** if this is your preference. IDWR would need to receive a simple letter asking to be an intervenor, referencing your name and the application for permit number 98-8018. If we do not hear from you within 21 days, a refund will be requested for your fee.


