ORDER VOIDING
APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

This matter having come before the Idaho Department of Water Resources (Department) as a requirement of Section 42-203C, Idaho Code, the Department finds, concludes and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Application for Permit No. 45-7616 (application) proposed the diversion of 2.0 cfs of groundwater for fish propagation use.
2. The Department mailed notice to the applicant on September 22 and November 25, 1987, informing him that the application was subject to the review requirements of Section 42-203C, Idaho Code. The notice further informed the applicant that he must submit to the Department information pursuant to the requirements of Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,3.
3. On October 24, 1990, the Department mailed a final notice requesting the applicant to provide the additional information within thirty (30) days or withdraw the application. The notice further informed the applicant that failure to submit the information within the specified time was cause for the Department to void the application. A response to the notice was not received.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Section 42-204, Idaho Code, specifies that failure on the part of the applicant to supply requested information within thirty (30) days is cause for the Director to void an application.

2. This application should be voided as provided in Section 42-204, Idaho Code.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application for Permit No. 45-7616 be VOIDED as provided in Section 42-204, Idaho Code.

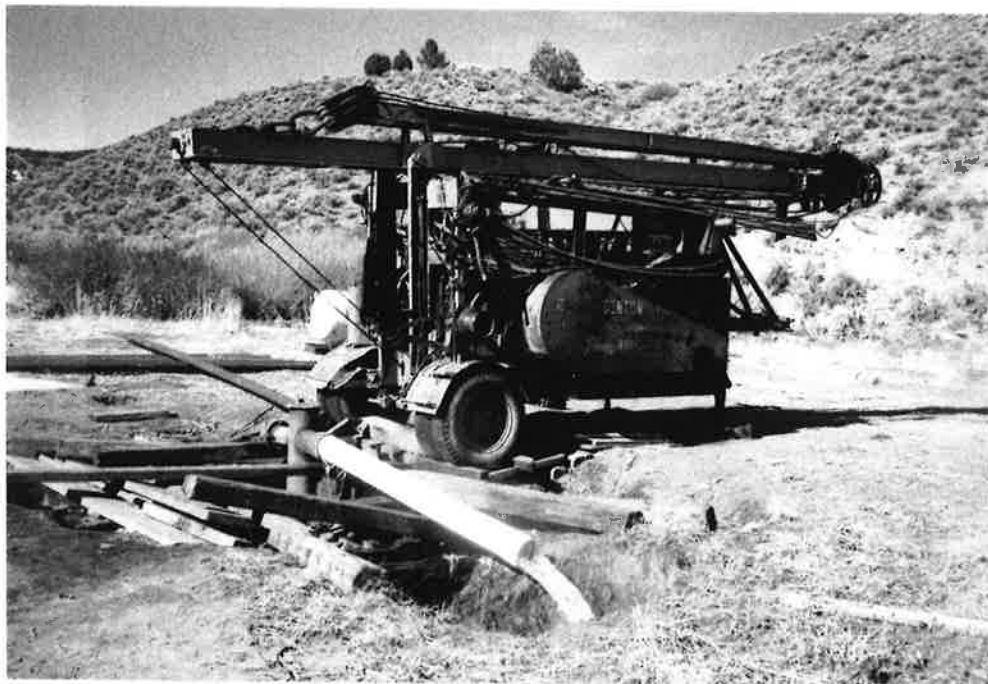

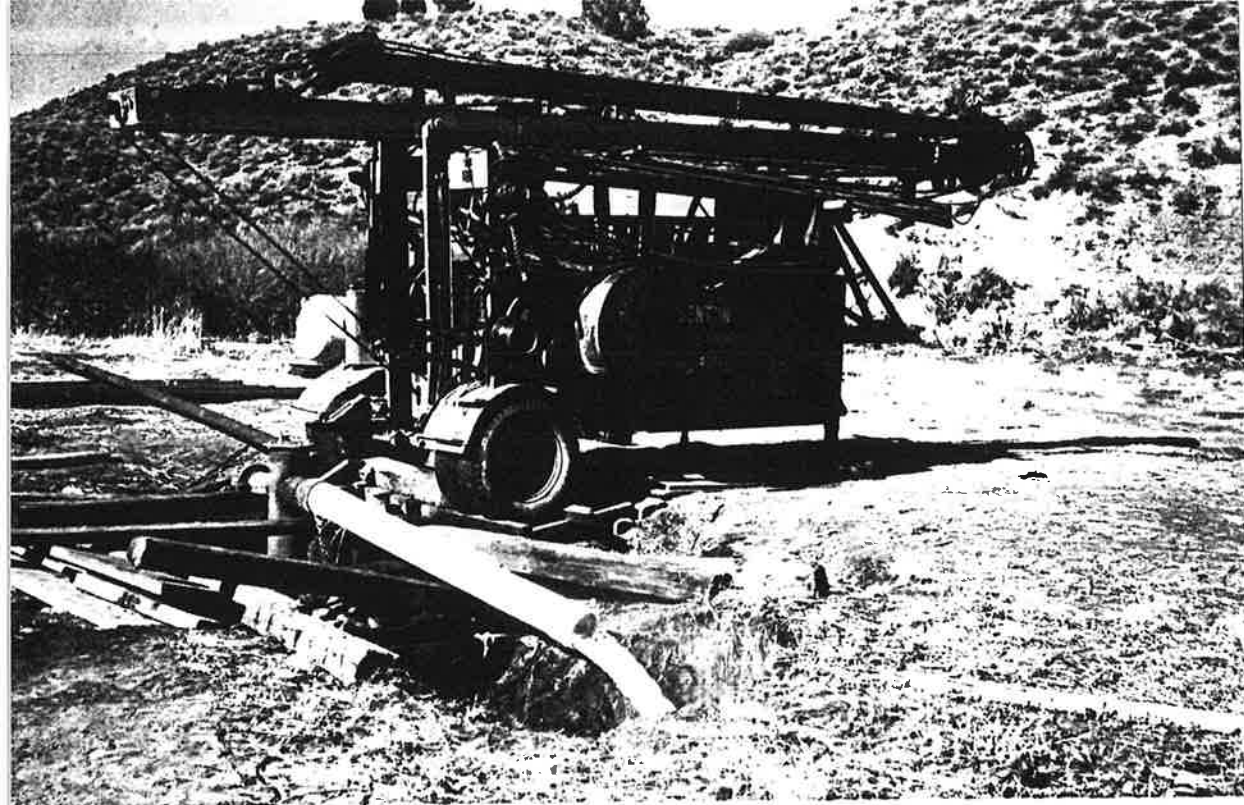

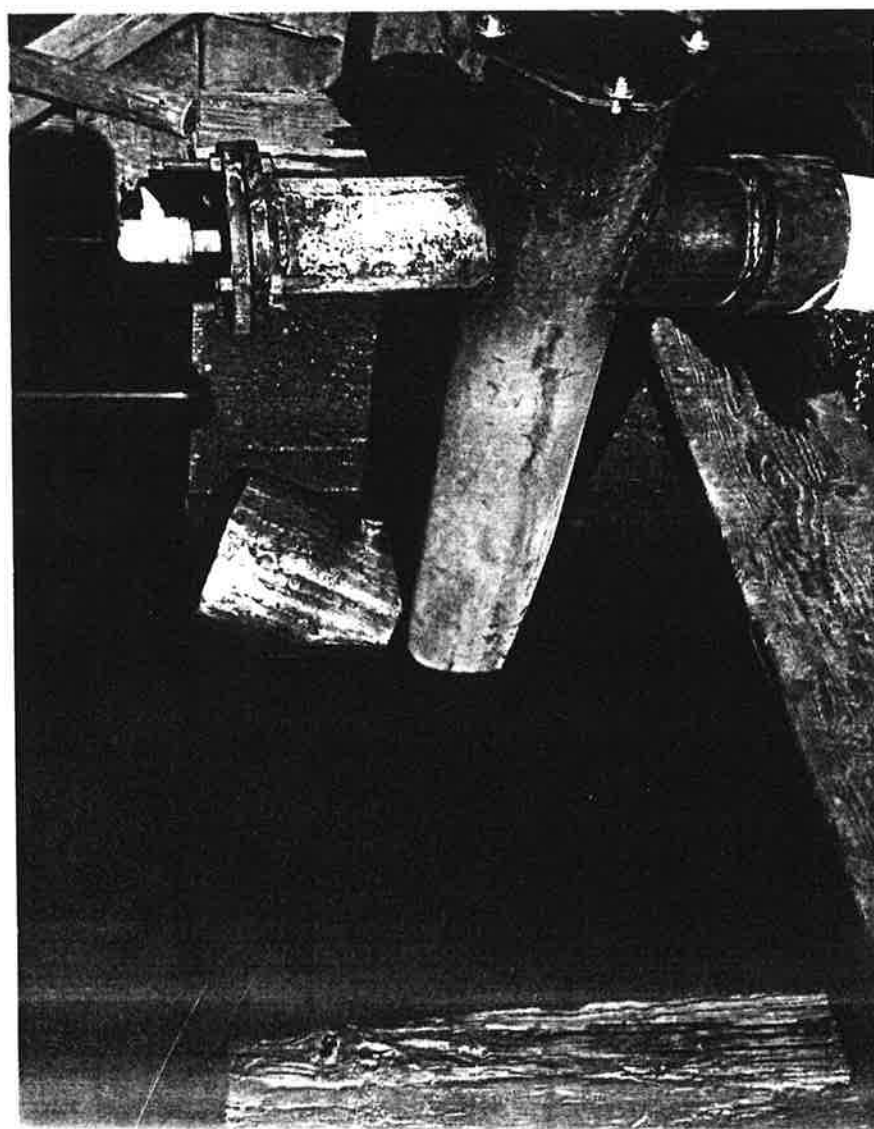
On this date I made contact with well driller Bob Denton in regards to well in SE1/4 NW1/4, Sec. 34, T14S, R21E. He cleaned the well out down to 1140 feet. He installed 190' of 5" casing with a thickness of 5/8". This casing is torch perforated in every other joint and sets between 910' and 1100 feet. He said owner had a TV camera lowered down well and understood it was previously cased from top to 985' with 6" casing with an undetermined amount of 10" casing from approximately 4' below land surface. Mr. Denton attached a 6' section of 10" casing to the top of the old 10" casing bringing it to its present elevation, approximately 2' above LSD. He said the old well also had a string of thin walled 16" or 20" casing from bottom of pit to an undetermined depth. There is an open pit (see photo) around well with water coming to the surface around well casing. Mr. Denton said owners were planning to pump water level down with a portable pump and fill this pit with concrete. Mr. Denton estimated flow from 10" casing approx. 400 gpm and at least that amount coming up around it. Temp. approx. 112°F. Mr. Denton also said there is a vidiocassette recording of what the camera saw inside the well. This cassette may be available for viewing from the owner.

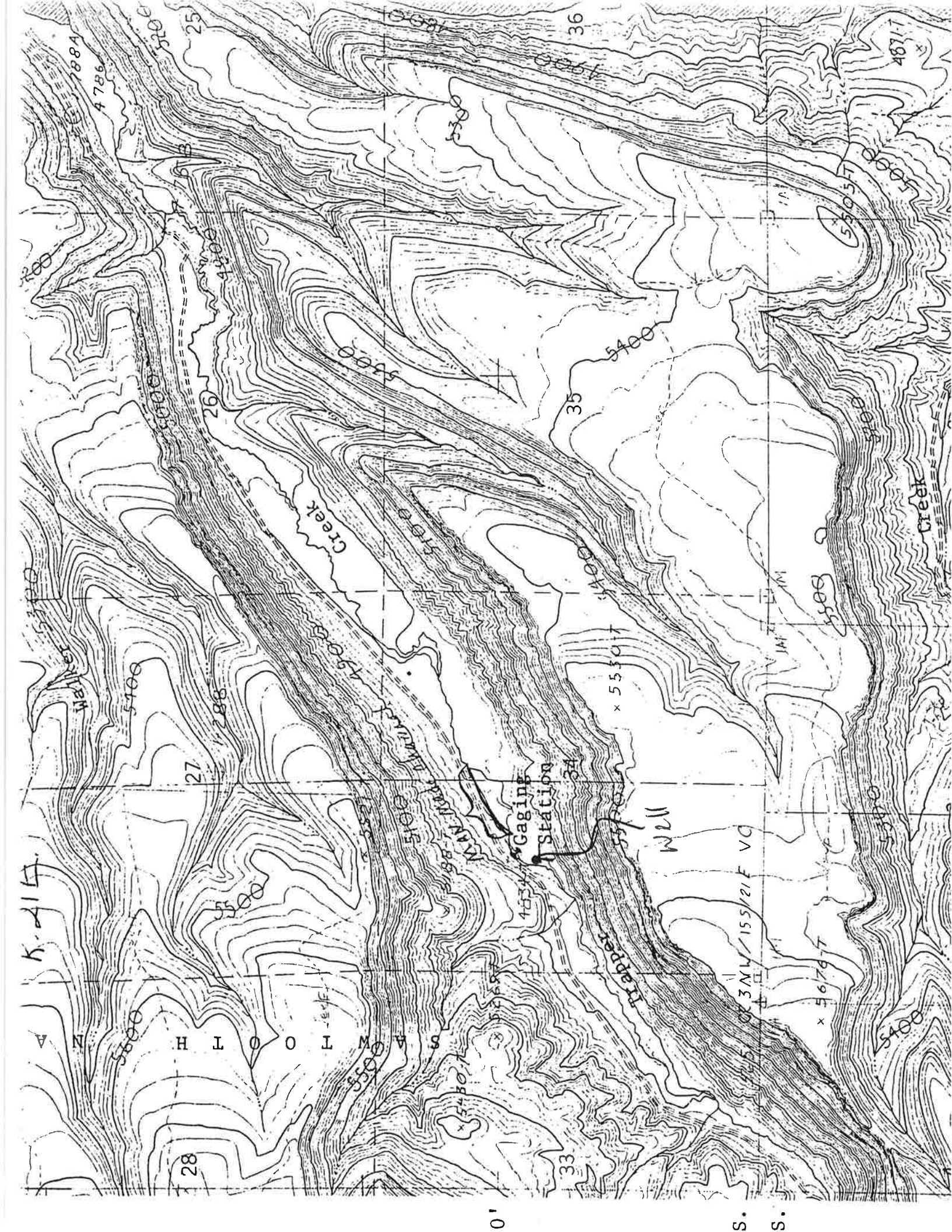
