

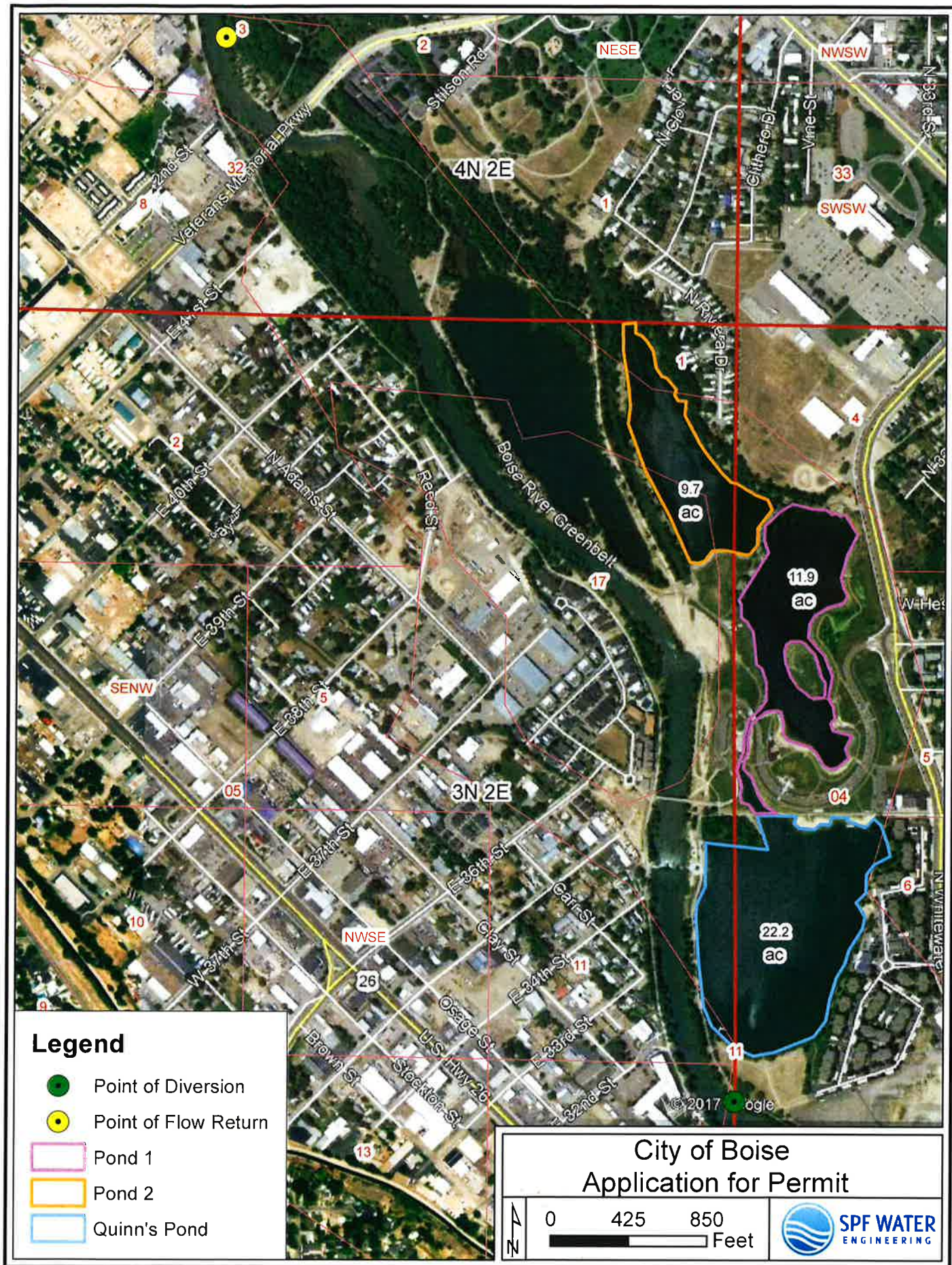

APPLICATION NARRATIVE

Applicant proposes non-consumptive flow-through water to improve water quality for aesthetic and recreation uses in a three-pond system at Esther Simplot and Bernadine Quinn Riverside Parks. Water will be diverted through park ponds and returned to the Boise River. The proposed flow-through water will be non-consumptive because water storage for the three ponds is authorized from the Boise River under decreed water rights 63-32350, 63-32351, and 63-32352, and mitigation for the evaporative losses resulting from the ponds will be accomplished by diverting 0.48 cfs of Thurman Mill water right 63-30130 (represented by 24 shares of Thurman Mill) into municipal storage in the ponds as proposed on the accompanying transfer application. Applicants have secured the 24 water shares from Thurman Mill Ditch Company, which more than adequately covers the consumptive uses resulting from the ponds.

A measuring device and lockable controlling works will be provided at the point of diversion.

The application does not propose diversion of storage water released specifically for stream flow maintenance purposes in the Boise River. This application does not propose to divert water released from storage to augment lower Snake River flows during the migration of Snake River salmon as authorized under Idaho law.
