Dear Mr. Blauer:

I have received your response to my letter and the department's trust water information questionnaire. Thank you for your prompt response.

I have reviewed your comments on the questionnaire and your original application file. I am somewhat confused about this filing. First, I notice that the application was filed for two sources of water, groundwater and waste water. The department should not have allowed you to file one application for two sources. Your comments on the questionnaire suggest that waste water is no longer available or used on your lands, and thus a waste water filing is possibly no longer needed.

Secondly, I have reviewed your adjudication claims and noticed that you filed a claim for the additional acres expanded under your license no. 45-2532. These expanded acres seem to match the same acreage under application 36-8241 that was not covered by your license 45-2532. You claimed a 1963 priority date under the expansion claim. Application no. 36-8241 has a 1985 priority date. If the adjudication claim adequately covers your expansion acreage, which I believe it does, and also provides you with an earlier priority, then it seems that application no. 36-8241 is not needed.

The only difference that may exist between your application and the other filings, including the license and adjudication claims, is that the application was filed with the intention of seeking a right to divert up to one inch per acre for all of your lands. Your licensed right already provides three-quarters of an inch per acre for the 415 licensed acres, and your adjudication claim provides a full inch per acre for the expanded acreage. The licensed right and adjudication claim should also provide you adequate volume for all your acreage. The new application will not provide you any additional volume than you already have or will receive under your other filings. With respect to diversion rates, I again question whether the application is needed.

I have enclosed a withdrawal form with this letter in case you should decide that the application is not needed. If complete and return the withdrawal form, the department will refund your application fee (\$105.00). In order to determine whether this

application is needed and whether your other filings adequately cover your irrigation uses, I would suggest that you visit our Twin Falls office and request assistance to review all of your existing rights. Upon reviewing your other filings, I think you will be able to asses what the status should be for the application in question. Our records show that Alan Merritt of our Twin Falls office previously assisted you with filing your adjudication claim.

You may contact me directly at 327-7864 if you have questions concerning this matter. Again though, I think the Twin Falls office will be able to assist you better if you visit that office personally.

Due to the Swan Falls litigation, Department approval of the enclosed application may have been delayed. The Department is presently reviewing your application and may authorize the proposed development.
