NOTICE OF PENDING ORDER VOIDING APPLICATION

On June 10, 1985, you filed with the Department of Water Resources (Department) Application for Permit No. 45-7575 which proposed the diversion of 1.66 cubic feet per second from wastewater for the irrigation of 83 acres.

The Department mailed a letter and questionnaire to you on July 6, 1990. The letter provided notice that the Department was reviewing the application in connection with development which was not complete prior to October 1, 1984.

This letter also requested that you return the Department's questionnaire concerning your present possessory interest in the place of use, any prior development under the application and/or your plans for pursuing completion of the proposed project. The letter notified you that failure to complete and return the questionnaire within thirty (30) days of the date of the letter was cause for the Department to void the application.

The purpose of this letter is to provide a second and final opportunity for you to submit the requested information. If you fail to respond to this inquiry within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter, the Department will issue an order voiding the application pursuant to Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,1.

If no development has been completed as authorized by the application, and you are no longer interested in pursuing the development, please complete and return the enclosed withdrawal form. Please note, if you are using water without an approved permit, the Department may issue an order requiring you to cease diverting the water.

Due to the Swan Falls litigation, Department approval of the enclosed application may have been delayed. The Department is presently reviewing your application and may authorize the proposed development.

The purpose of this letter is to determine: (1) if you are still interested in developing the project, and (2) the extent of development if any, that has already occurred under the application. Enclosed are two forms requesting information which will help the Department expedite the processing of the application.

1. If you have abandoned or have no interest in continuing with your plans for development of the project, please complete the enclosed withdrawal form and return it to the Department. If you request a withdrawal of the application and the application was not previously advertised, the department will refund your original filing fee.

2. If you wish to continue with your proposed development plans, or have completed all or a portion of the proposed development before October 1, 1984, then you must complete and return the enclosed questionnaire. You may use the questionnaire and enclosed application to make any comments &/or amendments concerning the application. Your completion of the questionnaire will expedite processing and help the department determine if the water diverted under the application is public water or trust water. Approved trust water applications may be subject to additional conditions.

Failure to return either of the above forms within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter is cause for the Department to void the application.

Please be further advised that if any undeveloped portion of your proposed project is greater than 200 acres, the Department will issue a notice requesting additional information as required by Water Appropriation Rule 4,5. (in particular, Rules 4,5,3. thru 4,5,3,5, apply to your project if it is more than 200 acres).

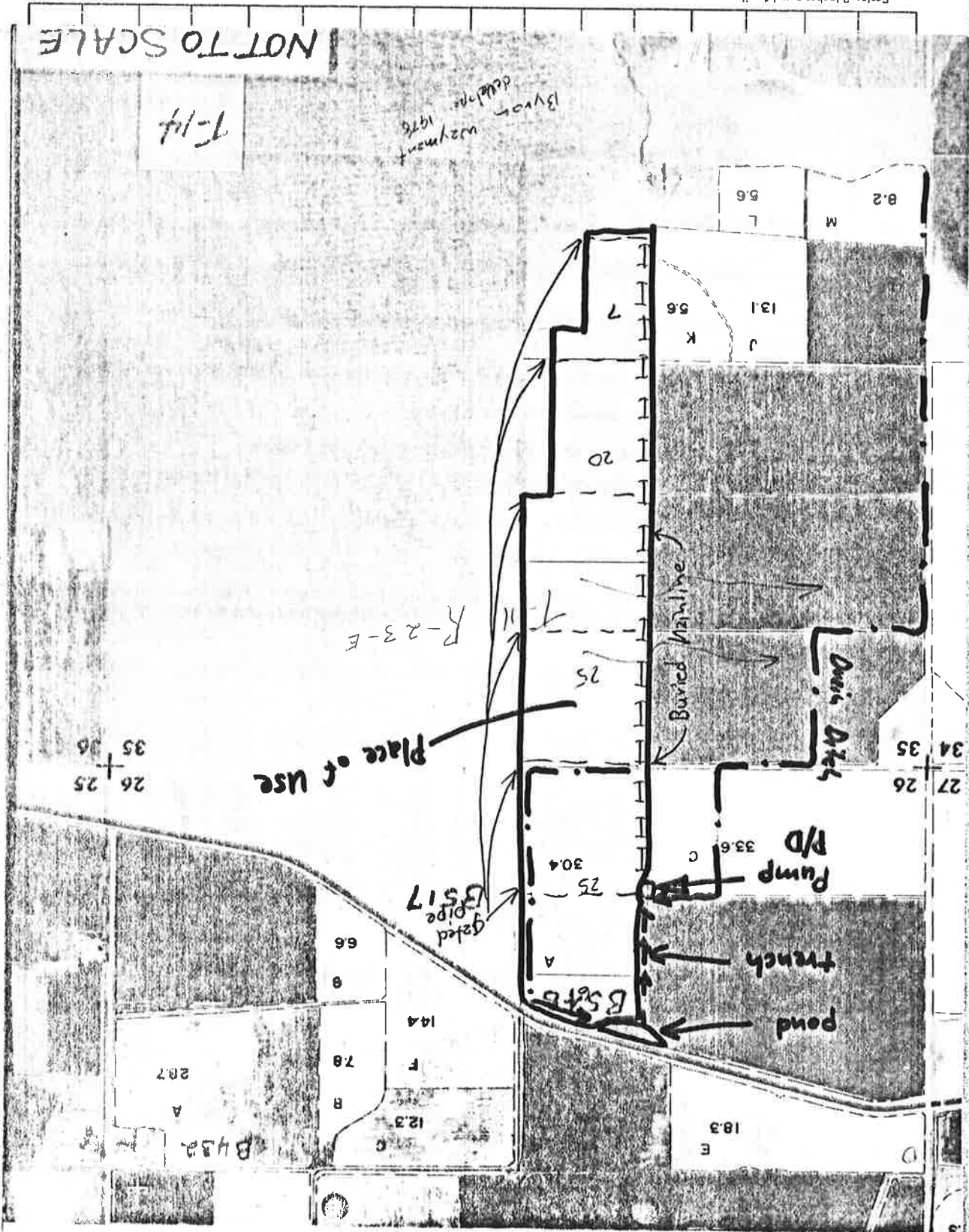

ORDER VOIDING APPLICATION
FOR PERMIT

This matter having come before the Idaho Department of Water Resources (Department) as a requirement of Section 42-203C, Idaho Code, the Department finds, concludes and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Application for Permit No. 45-7575 (application) proposed the diversion of 1.66 cfs from waste water for the irrigation of 83 acres of land.

2. The Department mailed notice to the applicant(s) on July 6, 1990, informing them that Application No. 45-7575 was subject to the review requirements of Section 42-203C, Idaho Code. The notice further informed the applicant(s) that they must submit to the Department within thirty (30) days information concerning development prior to October 1, 1984, and/or whether there is a continued interest in pursuing completion of the proposed development.

3. On August 14, 1990, the Department mailed a second notice requesting the applicant to provide the additional information within fifteen (15) days or withdraw the application. The notice further informed the applicant that failure to submit the information within the specified time was cause for the

Department to void the application. A response to this notice was not received.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. Section 42-204, Idaho Code, specifies that failure on the part of the applicant to supply requested information within thirty (30) days is cause for the Director to void an application.

2. The application should be voided as provided in Section 42-204, Idaho Code.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application for Permit No. 45-7575 be VOIDED as provided in Section 42-204, Idaho Code.
