Dear Denise,

Thank you for the opportunity to review the Applications for Permit No. 47-17716 and 47-17717, which seek to appropriate a total of 7.4 cfs for sugar beet processing from June 2 – September 14. Water will be diverted from an existing dam on Rock Creek (47-17717) and from the Tunnel Drain (47-17716). The Idaho Department of Fish and Game (IDFG) offers the following comments for your consideration:

IDFG understands that the proposed industrial use is non-consumptive and that water will be discharged back into Rock Creek downstream of the PODs. Because water used under these permits would be discharged into a natural stream channel, we recommend conditioning the applications that discharged water should meet Idaho Water Quality Standards.
