State of Idaho, deposes and says:

That he is the holder, or the duly authorized agent of the holder*, of Permit to Appropriate the Public Water of the State of Idaho No. 37-7429.

That under the terms and conditions of said permit, work thereunder was required to be completed on or before April 1, 19 85.

That he has heretofore performed the following work described under said permit: a well has been drilled to approximately 200 ft., however, the drill bit has been lost in the well making it impossible to continue with. Approximately 160 has been placed under irrigation with the North Side Canal Co. water.

Costing \$ 100,000

That he is unable to complete the remainder of the work within the required time for the following reasons, to-wit:

We have been prevented from completing the project because of the Swan Falls litigation and the poor economic conditions.

Wherefore, he asks that the Department of Water Resources extend the time for the completion of obligations under said permit to April 1, 19 90.

IN THE NAME OF JOHN C. PARKE

WHEREAS, on March 6, 1975, John C. Parke applied to the Department of Water Resources for a permit to appropriate 3.00 cubic feet per second of water from a groundwater source to be diverted within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 34, Twp. 5S, Rge. 11E B.M. Elmore County, to be used for irrigation purposes; and,

WHEREAS, on April 19, 1975, the Department approved said application and issued Permit No. 37-7429 with the condition that proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use be submitted to the Department on or before April 1, 1980; and,

WHEREAS, on March 26, 1980, the permit holder submitted a request for an extension of time; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that under the circumstances, the permit holder has been proceeding with reasonable diligence and has given good cause for delay;

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which to submit proof of beneficial use of water under Permit No. 37-7429 be extended to April 1, 1985.
