WHEREAS, on December 7, 1971, Glens Ferry Industrial Development Corporation filed with the Department of Water Administration an application for permit to appropriate 40 cubic feet per second of water from Bancroft Springs, tributary to the Snake River, from a point within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, of Sec. 4, Twp. 6S, Rge. 11E, B.M., Elmore County, to be used for fish propagation purposes; and,

WHEREAS, on December 20, 1971, the Department requested the applicant to submit additional information within 30 days in connection with said application; and,

WHEREAS, on January 18, 1972, the Department extended the time for submission of the required information to April 30, 1972; and,

WHEREAS, on November 28, 1972, the Department received an assignment whereby Glens Ferry Industrial Development Corporation assigned all their right, title, and interest in and to said Application for Permit No. 37-7120 to Robert D. Graham; and,

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1973, the Department advised Mr. Graham that additional information was required to complete the application; and,

WHEREAS, on May 18, 1973, the applicant was notified by certified mail that Application for Permit No. 37-7120 would be voided unless he could show cause on or before June 1, 1973; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant has failed to respond and said application is incomplete as filed; and,

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED and Application for Permit No. 37-7120 is hereby voided pursuant to Section 42-204 of the Idaho Code.

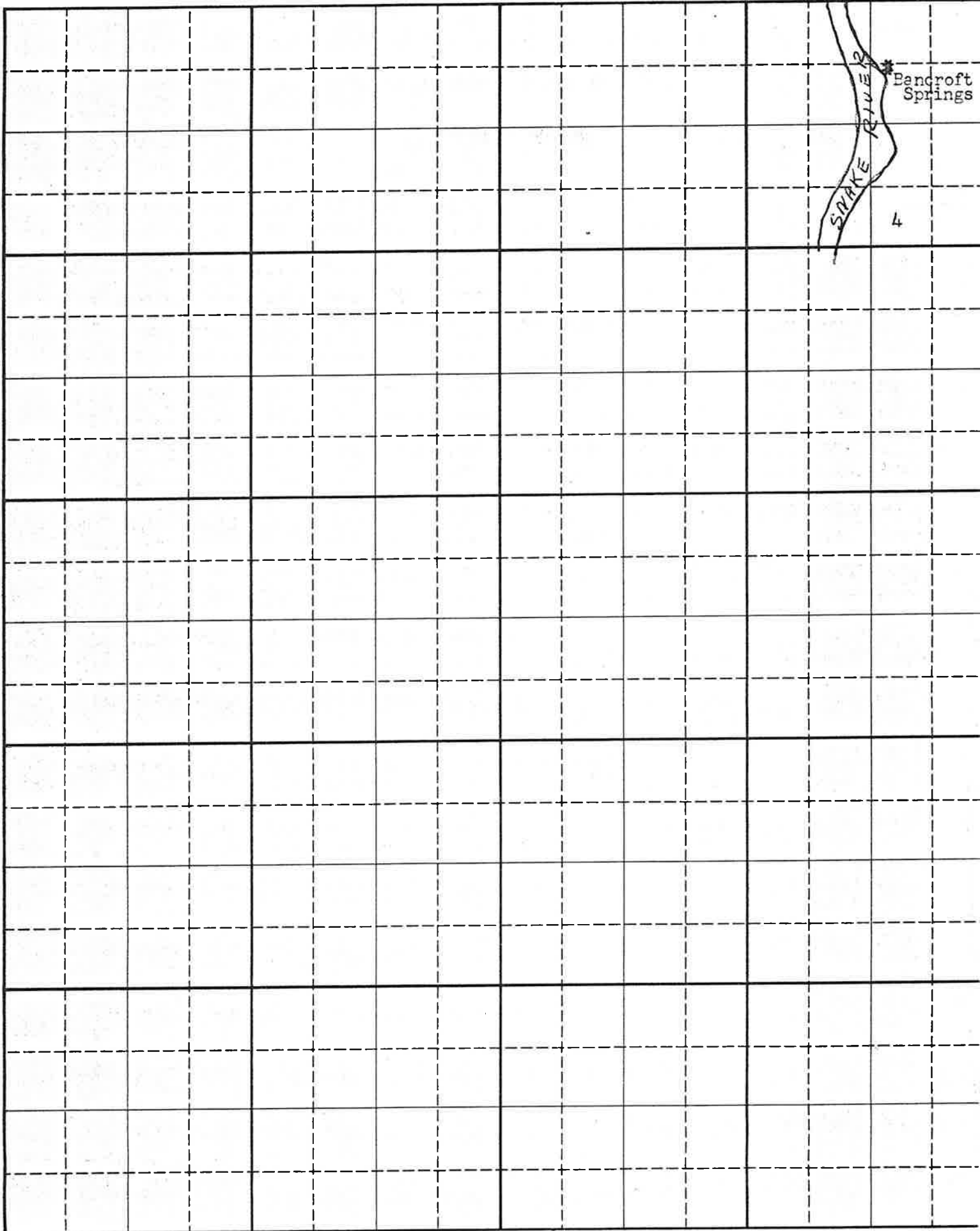
10. Remarks The long range goal of the Glenns Ferry Industrial Development Corp. is to establish a commercial fish processing plant in Glenns Ferry to bolster the local economy by creating 25 - 50 new jobs. In order to make this venture economically feasible, a fish hatchery is needed in our locality. The hatchery, utilizing the water of Bancroft Springs, should be able to supply sufficient young trout - to be raised at the hatchery site and in a local "farm pond" operation - to make the processing plant a workable situation.

The actual hatchery construction details are still in the planning stage, but generally speaking, the spring water would have to be diverted by ditch about 50 - 100 yards downstream to supply a hatchery building and adequate concrete rearing ponds. The number of ponds will depend on the actual amount of water available.

After the water is utilized in this manner, it would be discharged into the Snake River.

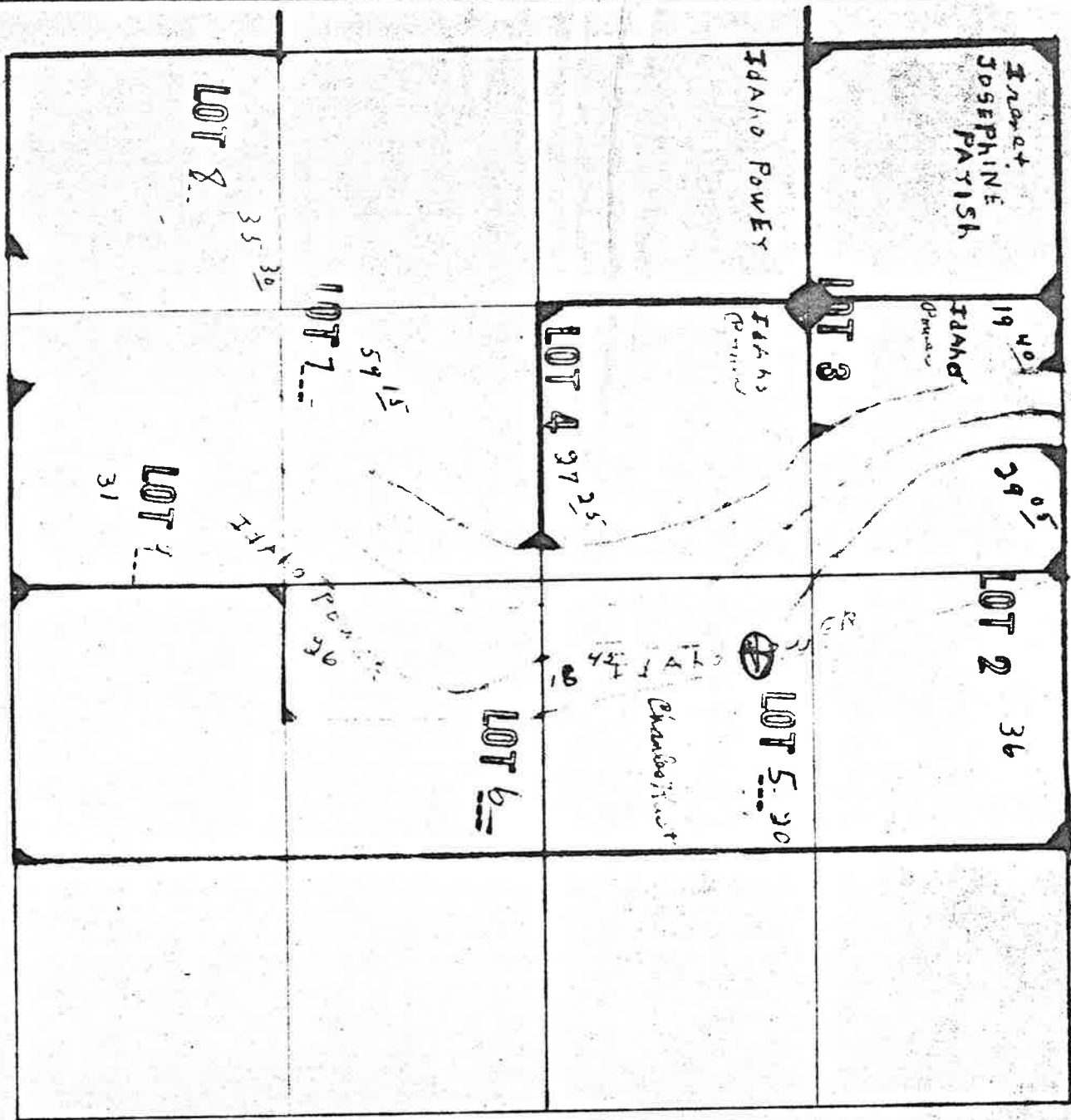
