#### RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE


- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- 2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. This rental does not authorize the construction of a well.
- 10. Use of water under this rental may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 143.
- 11. - 13. When combined with the above listed water rights, this rental authorizes a maximum combined diversion rate of 113.7 cfs and 26,086.7 afa for the irrigation of 6,532.8 acres within a 9,204 acre permissible place of use.
- 14. When combined with the above listed water rights, this rental authorizes a maximum combined diversion rate of 118.3 cfs and 27,869.5 afa for irrigation and commercial/stock water uses on East Farm.
- 15. Renter shall maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type approved by the Department in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversions.



**PURPOSE/NARRATIVE:** On March 20, 2020, Brockway Engineering ("representative") submitted an application to rent water on behalf of East Valley Cattle ("applicants"). In a letter submitted with the application by the representative, the proposed rental is described as a renewal of a previous rental agreement (Rental Agreement # 283 (2019)).

The proposed rental is for the irrigation of acres that are no longer receiving water, due to the curtailment of expansion acre water rights in Basin 43.

The applicants propose renting the same quantity of water from the same water rights, 43-2347 and 43-2413, for the same number of acres and place of use ("POU"). The proposed rental is for three years, ending on December 31, 2022.

**AUTHORITY TO FILE:** The application was signed by William J (Bill) Millenkamp who is the registered agent for East Valley Cattle LLC. The proposed points of diversion and places of use appear to be on tax parcels that belong to the applicant. There are no concerns with authority to file at this time.

**WATER RIGHT VALIDITY:** Satellite imagery indicate that the POUs for 43-2347 and 43-2413 were irrigated within the five years prior to being leased to the Water Supply Bank in 2018. Satellite imagery and correspondence with the lessor were used to confirm that the leased rights were idled.

**INJURY TO OTHER WATER RIGHTS:** ESPA modeling was not required. There is no apparent injury to other rights through the proposed rental.

**ENLARGEMENT OF USE:** The applicant is requesting a renewal of the previous agreement (Rental Agreement No. 283 (2019)). Based on the 2019 review, enlargement does not appear to be a concern.

The number of acres authorized under the rental will be reduced to maintain a per acre rate of 0.017 cfs/acre. Similarly, since the number of acres is being reduced, the volume needs to be reduced otherwise there would be enlargement concerns. The volume should be reduced so that a volume of 4 af/acre is being maintained, consistent with the other rights that are used to irrigate land within the PPU. Both reductions are based on the analysis done for the 2019 agreement, more detailed information can be found in the review memo for rental application 1129 dated January 3, 2019.

The proposed rental is for the irrigation of acres that are not covered by existing water rights within a shared PPU. The PPU includes some water rights that have been curtailed because they are enlargement rights. No overlap was found between the requested rental and the other water rights within the PPU.

**LOCAL PUBLIC INTEREST**: Review staff has no information to suggest this application is inconsistent with the local public interest.

**BENEFICIAL USE/CONSERVATION OF WATER RESOURCES:** The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

**DEPARTMENT STAFF OR WATERMASTER COMMENTS:** On June 2, 2020, comments were requested from Southern Region and the watermaster for Water District 143. No comments were received, the review staff assumes that there are no concerns with the proposed rental.

East Valley Cattle and US Geothermal Inc. C/O Ormat Nevada Inc. have entered into an agreement regarding water rights 43-2413 and 43-2347. East Valley Cattle has agreed to rent the full irrigation amount of water under these two water right for 2020, 2021 and 2022. Because East Valley Cattle and US Geothermal Inc. C/O Nevada Inc. have a side agreement in place, it is expected that only the annual 10% current IDWR rental processing fee will be paid when the rental contracts are finalized and when annual rental payments are due.
