LAPSE NOTICE
LICENSE EXAMINATION FEE


You are hereby notified that under the provisions of Sec. 42-217 and 42-218a, Idaho Code, the above referenced permit lapsed and is of no further force nor effect for failure of the permit holder(s) to submit either the license examination fee or an acceptable field examination report prepared by or under the supervision of a certified water right examiner.

Provisions of Sec. 42-217, Idaho Code and the Beneficial Use Examination Rules and Regulations provide that failure of the permit holder(s) to submit either the fee or an acceptable field examination report within one year and sixty days after notification by the director that the submittal is due is cause for the director to reject the proof of beneficial use and lapse the permit. The department notified you of the required submittal on August 11 1987.

The lapsed permit can be reinstated upon a showing of reasonable cause for late submittal of proof of beneficial use, if you submit to the department within sixty days, either the license examination fee or an acceptable field examination report prepared by or under the supervision of a certified water right examiner.

Enclosed is a fee information sheet that must be completed and submitted to the department to keep the permit in good standing. If you have questions, please contact any office of the department.

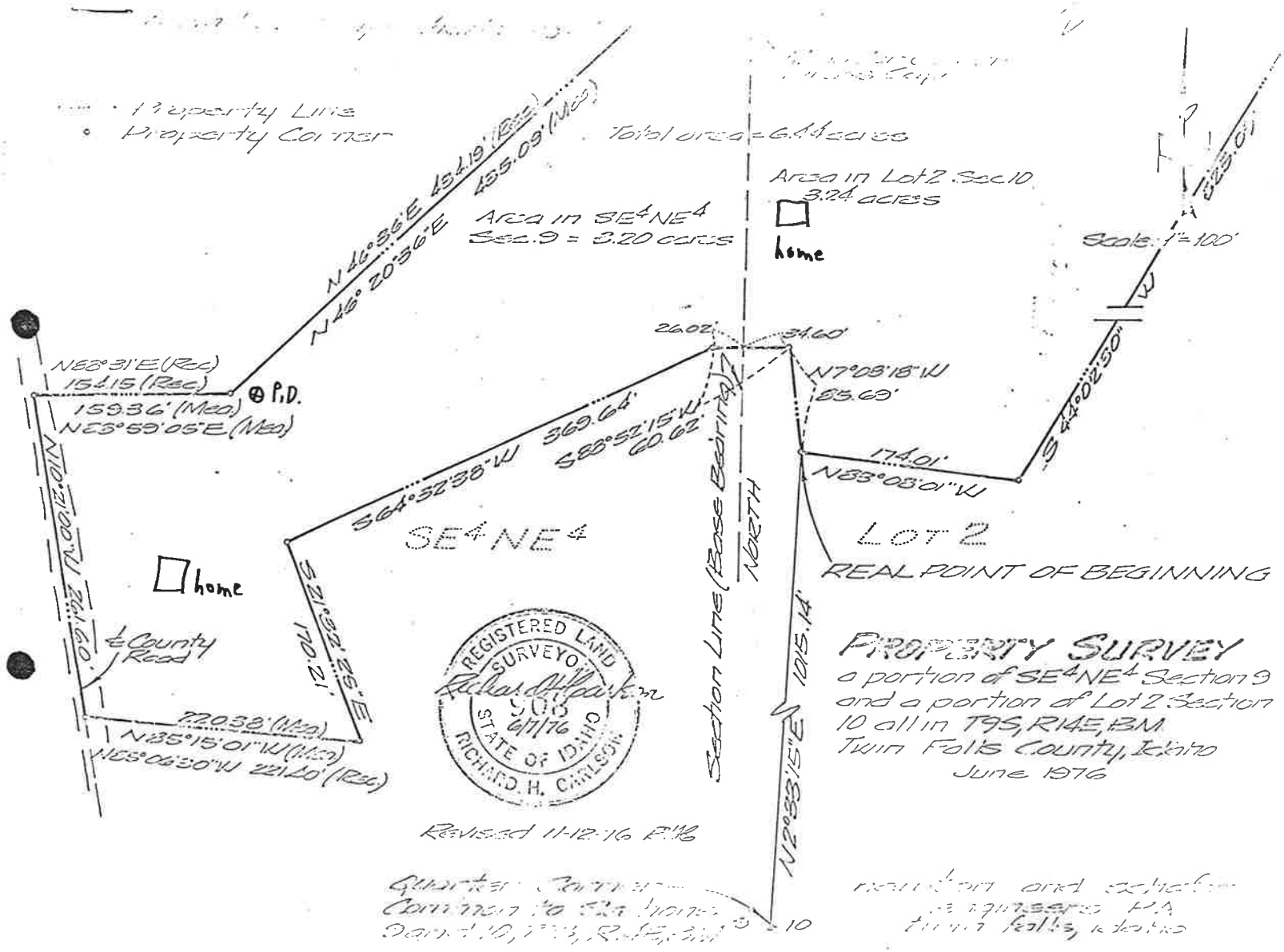

ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-7576, and said application is hereby approved.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.
- b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before November 1, 19 84.
- c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
- d. Other: (1) Return water shall be treated to insure that the effluent meets intrastate stream water quality standards. (2) The issuance of this permit in no way grants any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
